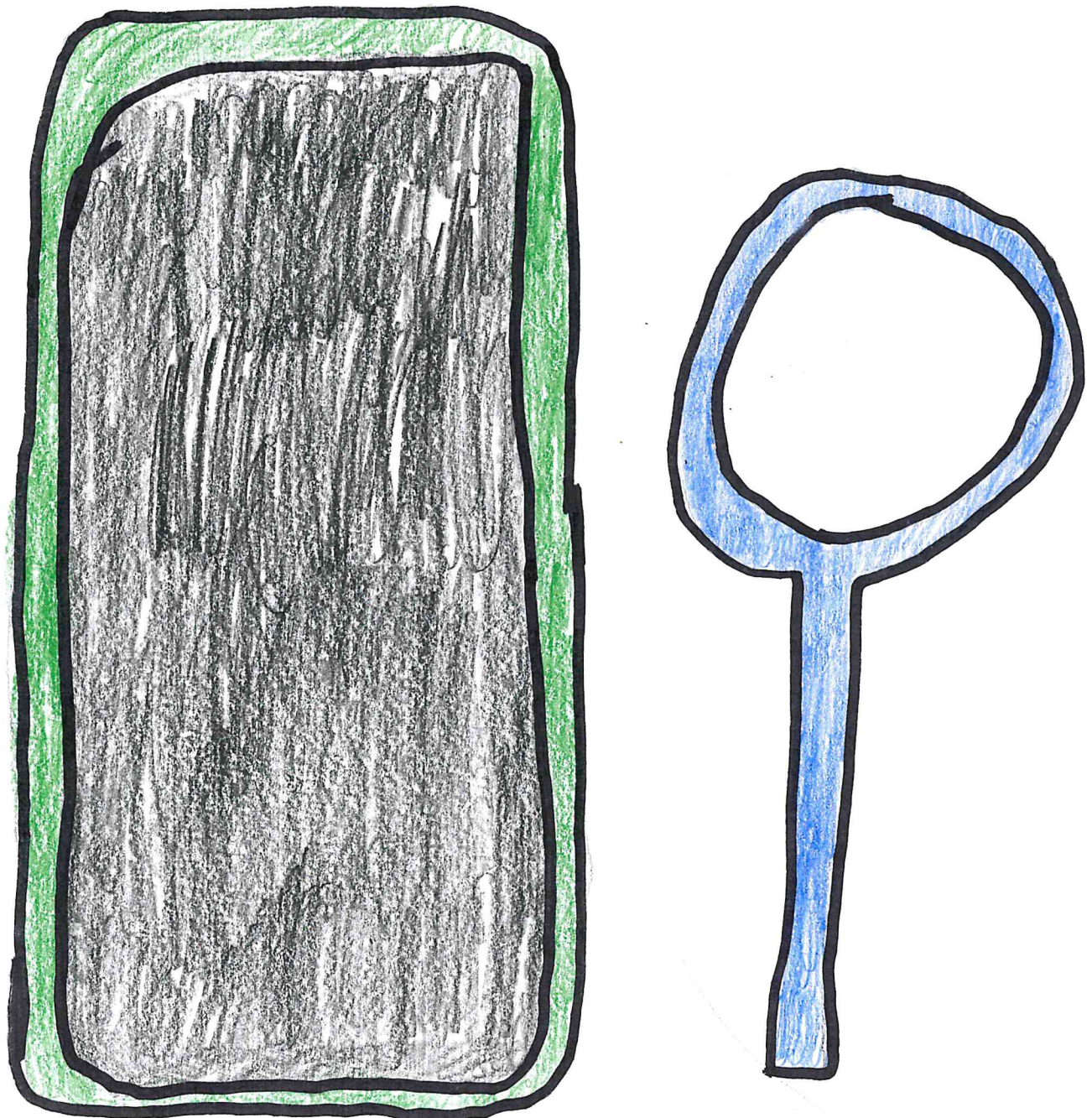


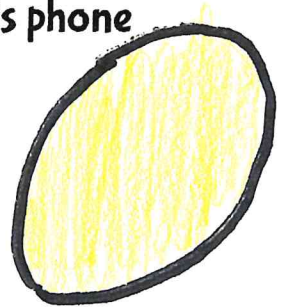
**The Mystery Of The

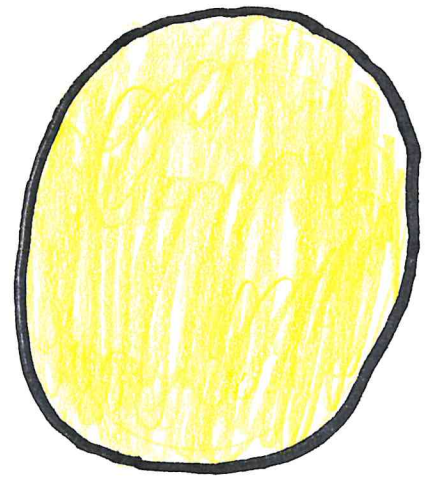
"My phone!" Steve yelled.

And they did.

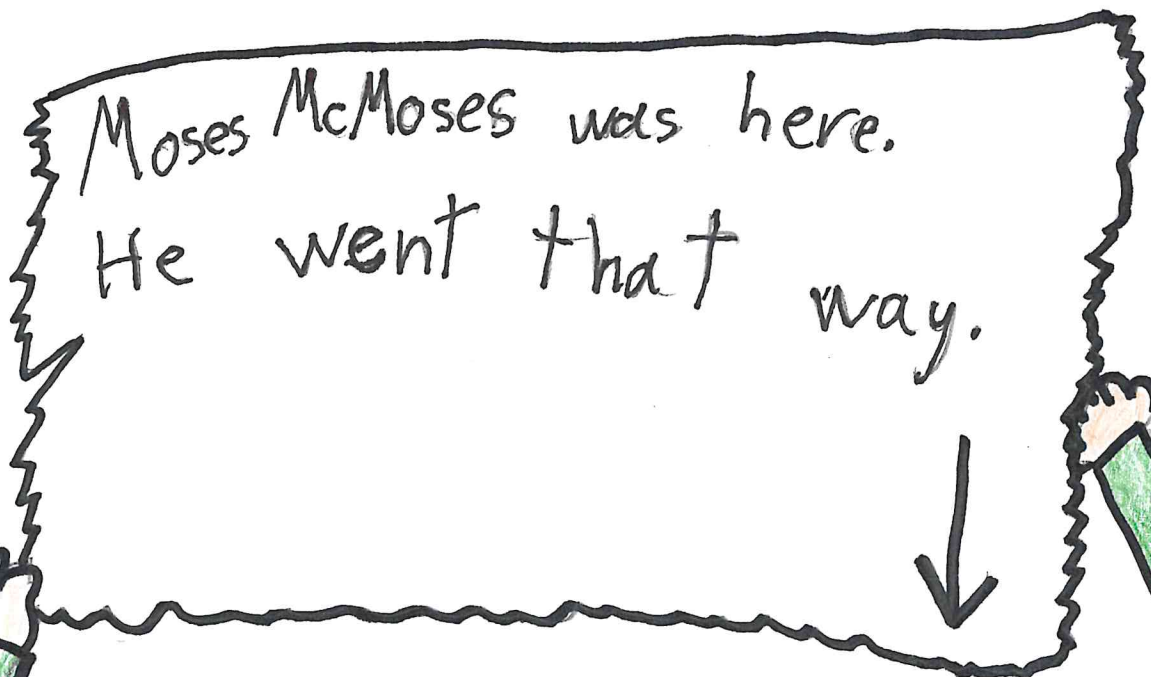
They found the fingerprints of Moses McMoses.
