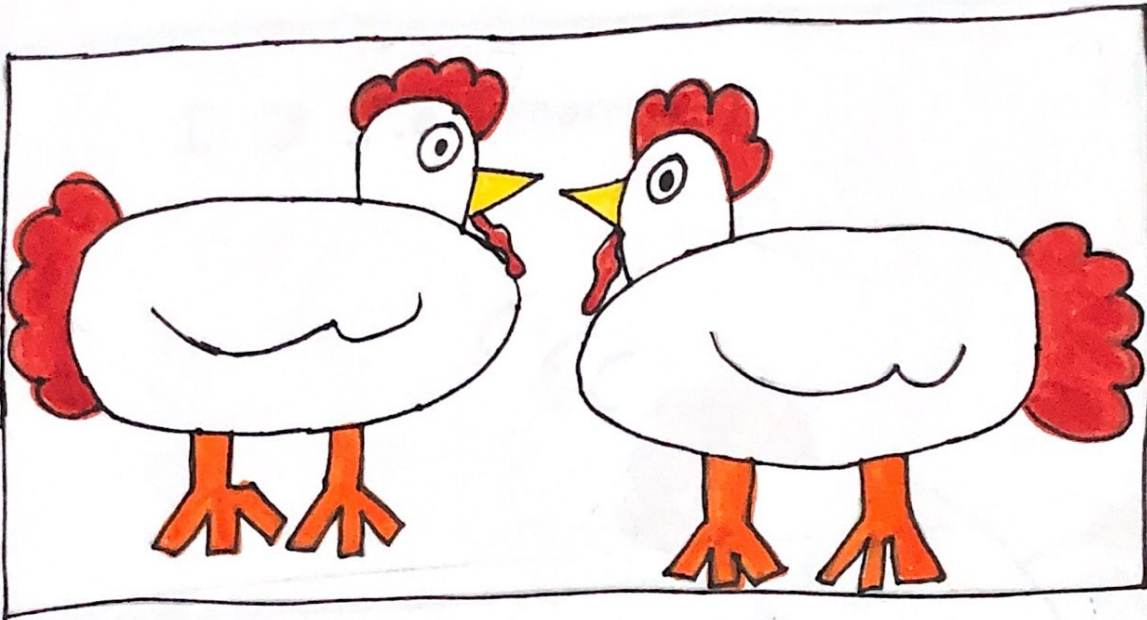
There once was a girl named Martha and she loved to draw. She always made pictures for all the people she met.



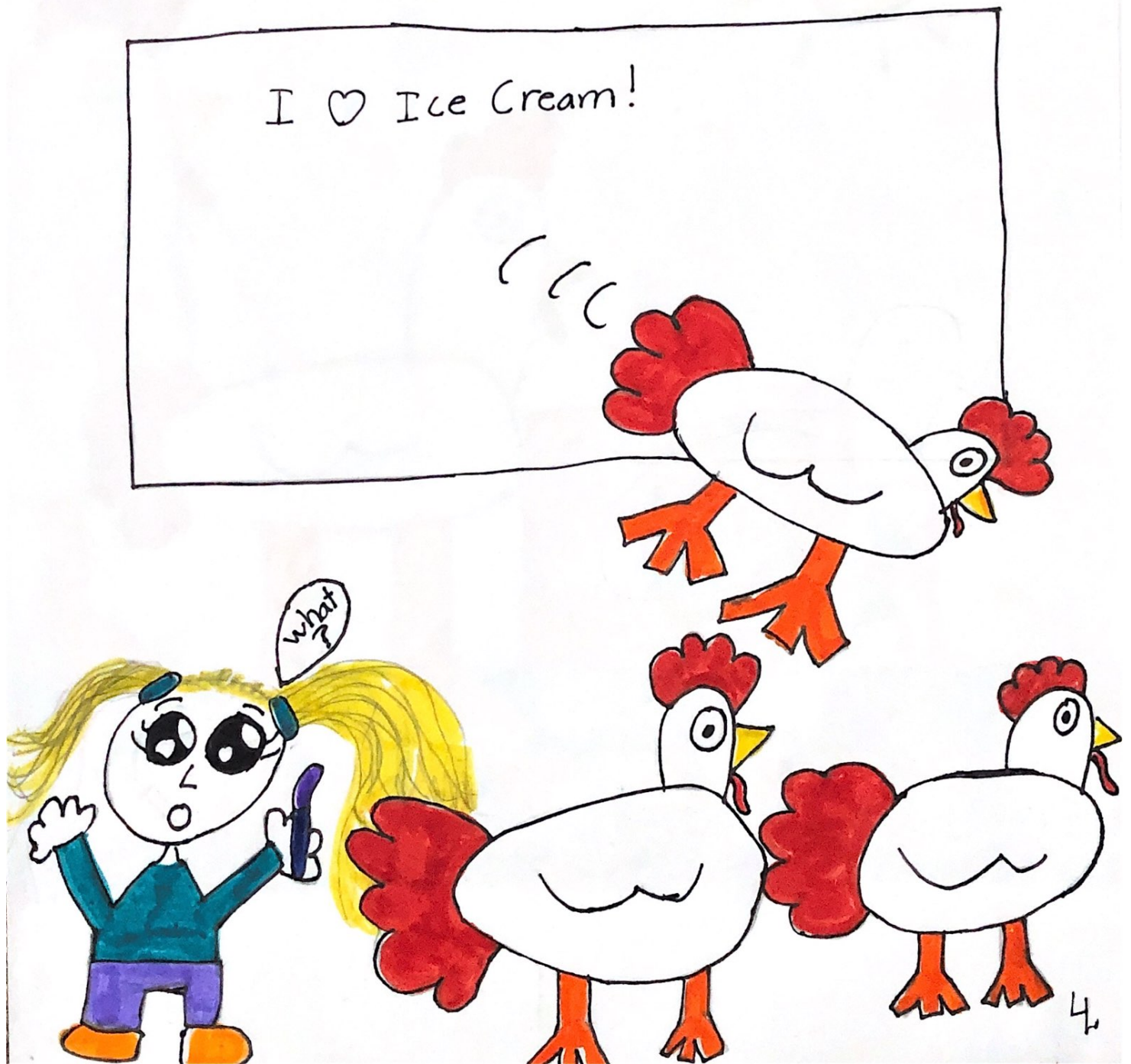

Martha said "Thank you for the paintbrush," and thought about what she wanted to draw. She decided to draw giant chickens with big feet who loved to eat ice cream!



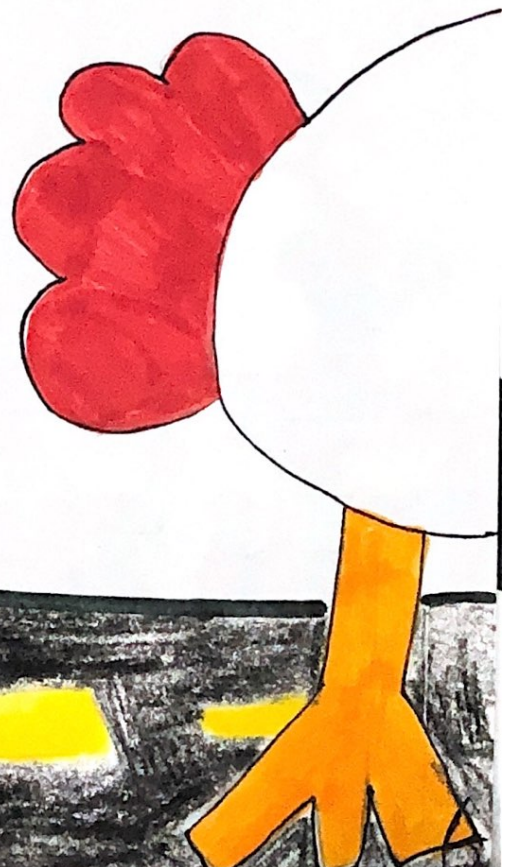
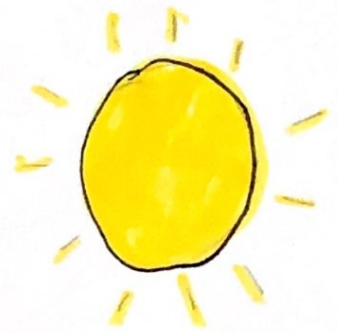

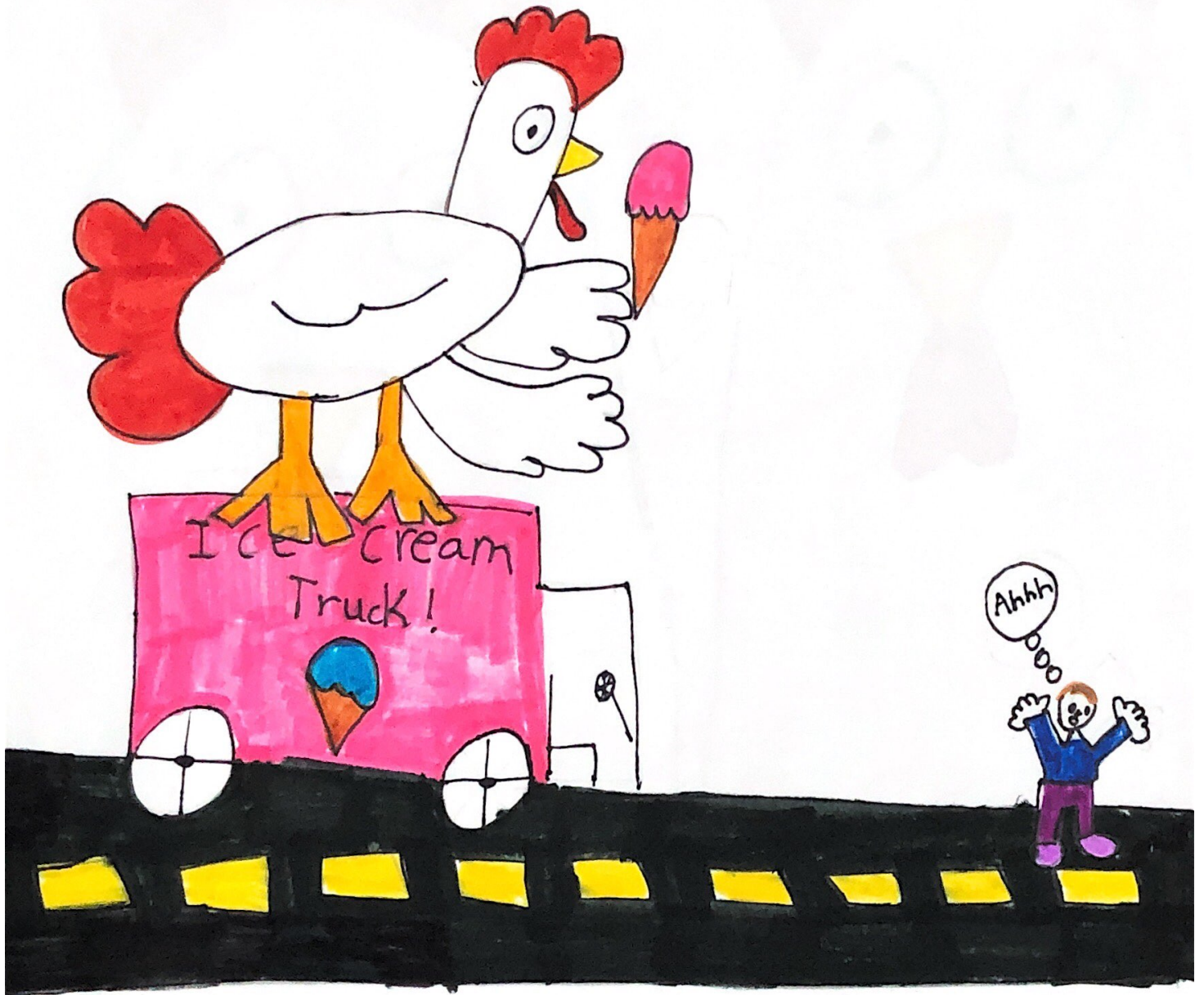
The chickens heard music in the distance. They looked down the street and saw an ice cream truck and began to chase it. "ICE CREAM!", they clucked.



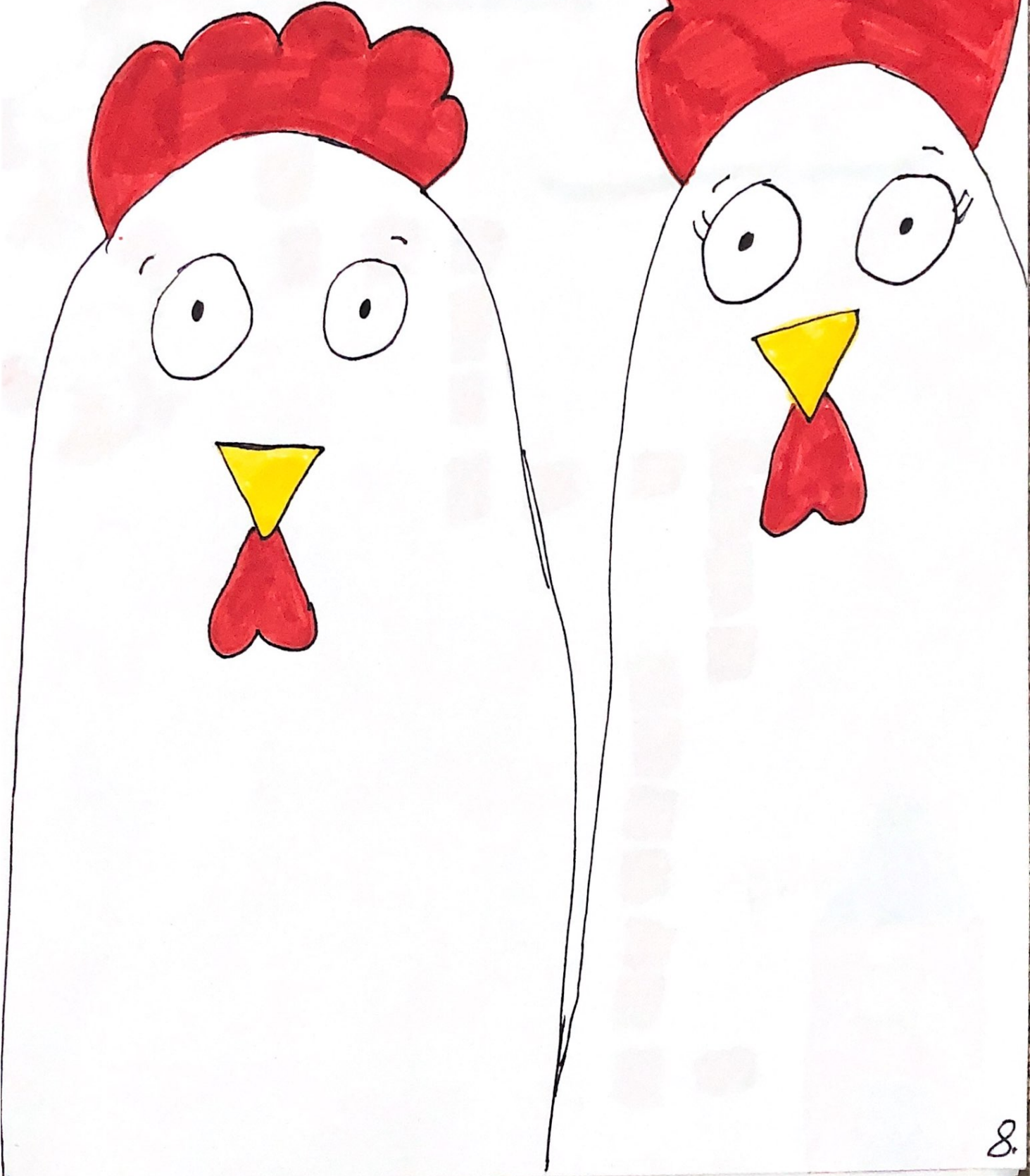
The chickens chased the ice cream truck through the whole city. Martha was trying to keep up with them on her bike. They kept running and running, but they were too fast for her.



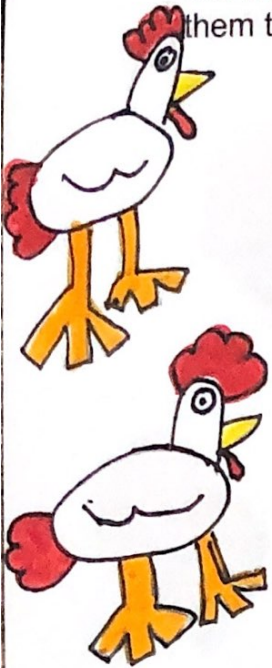

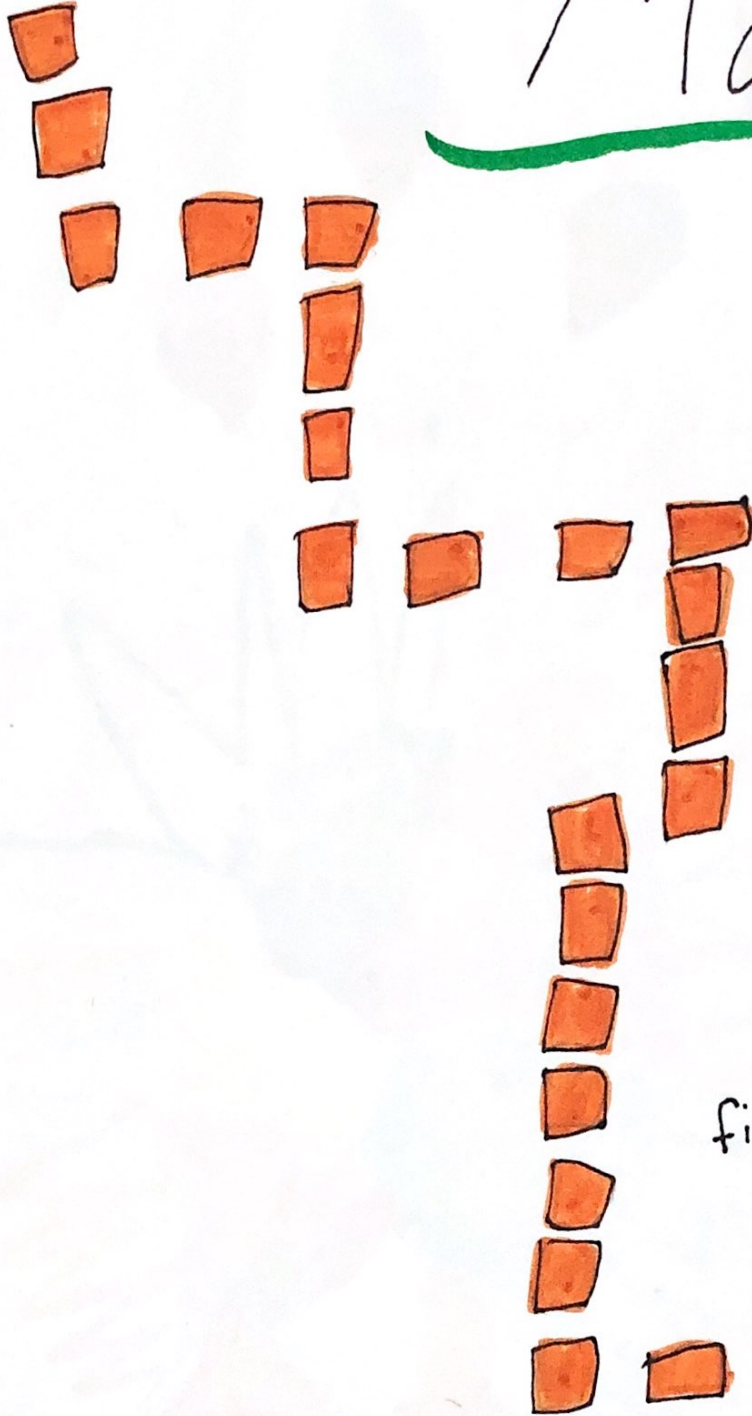
They ate and ate and got bigger and bigger.
