Bored with the ordinary? Searching for something completely different? If you have an adventurous spirit, love the great outdoors . . . appreciate crystal clear lakes, mountain streams, the ocean's roar . . . wildlife in their natural habitat . . . kayaks and schooners . . . this is THE TOUR you've been waiting for!

ITINERARY

Day One – Departing from Maryland Public Television, early this morning, you will head north today, making customary rest and lunch (at your own expense) stops en route. Late this afternoon you will arrive in Manchester, NH and check into the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel for one (1) night. Dinner is included at a local restaurant. (DINNER)

Day Two – Following breakfast and checkout, you will travel to Lake Winnepesaukee for a sightseeing cruise along the lake. After the lake cruise you will continue to travel north, making a one (1) hour lunch stop (at your own expense) en route. Arriving in Rangeley later this afternoon, you will check into the Rangeley Inn, your home away from home for the next two (2) nights. Witness the grandeur and charm of Rangeley's past in this beautifully restored landmark property dating to the late 19th century. Situated between Haley Pond in back and Rangeley Lake out front, you'll find it to be a picture postcard location. Dinner is included this evening in the main dining room. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

Day Three – After an early wake-up continental breakfast, it's time to head out with local guides for a fun-filled "Moosewatch" kayak trip. As you glide down the Cupsuptic River keep an eye out for native wildlife including moose, deer, beaver, fox, blue heron, loons and osprey. Return to the Inn for a mouthwatering full breakfast and maybe a nap. This afternoon, board your motorcoach and say hello to a local guide who will take you on a tour of the area and give you the history of the Rangeley Lakes region. After another incredible dinner at the inn, board your coach for a sunset drive to look for moose in "Moose Alley". (BREAKFAST, DINNER)



Day Four – After a hearty breakfast and checkout, you’ll say goodbye to the Rangeley Inn and take a scenic drive to Camden, ME. Enjoy some free time in this picturesque harbor town for browsing, shopping and lunch on your own. This afternoon the adventure continues! Hop aboard a schooner, sit back and take pictures as you set sail out of the harbor into delightful Penobscot Bay. Following the cruise, you’ll head down the coast and check in at the Hampton Inn and Suites, Rockland, ME. Dinner is included this evening. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

Day Five – After breakfast and checkout this morning, a local guide will take you on a tour of the Boothbay area. Following the tour, you’ll head down the coast to Freeport, ME, where you will have time to visit L.L. Bean’s flagship store as well as have lunch (at your own expense). This evening you will stop for one (1) night at the Courtyard by Marriott Boston Andover, Andover, MA. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. (BREAKFAST, DINNER)

Day Six – Following breakfast and checkout, you’ll head into Boston and pick up a local guide who will take you on a historic tour of the city. Following the tour, you’ll have time to have lunch (at your own expense) at Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall Marketplace before you depart for home. En route we will make rest stops and a dinner stop (at your own expense. (BREAKFAST)

GENERAL LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

Unless otherwise shown below, these exclusions apply to the Insured, the Insured's Traveling Companion, or Family Member scheduled and booked to travel with the Insured.

The following exclusion applies to the Trip Cancellation and Trip Interruption and Medical Expense:

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from a Pre-Existing Medical Condition, as defined in the plan.

The following exclusions apply to the Medical Expense benefits.

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from:

1. routine physical examinations or routine dental care;
2. traveling for the purpose or intent of securing medical treatment or advice;
3. Alcohol or substance abuse or treatment for the same;
4. Normal pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or childbirth, or elective abortion;
5. a Mental, Nervous or Psychological Condition or Disorder unless Hospitalized or Partially Hospitalized while the plan is in effect;
6. the Insured's participation in Adventure or Extreme Activities, riding or driving in races, or participation in speed or endurance competition or events, except as a spectator;
7. the Insured's participation in an organized athletic or sporting competition, contest, or stunt under contract in exchange for an agreed-upon salary or compensation. This does not include athletes participating in exchange for a scholarship or tuition.

The plan also contains exclusions specific to Baggage & Personal Effects and Baggage Delay.

In addition to any applicable benefit-specific exclusion, the following general exclusions apply to all losses and all benefits.

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from:

1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of the Insured, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner booked and scheduled to travel with the Insured, while sane or insane;
2. being under the influence of drugs or narcotics, unless administered upon the advice of a Physician as prescribed;
3. activities, losses, or claims involving or resulting from possession, production, processing, sale, or use of marijuana, illegal drugs, alcohol or substances are excluded from coverage;
4. war or act of war, including invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities between nations (whether declared or undeclared), or civil war;
5. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation by the Insured, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner;
6. directly or indirectly, the actual, alleged or threatened use, discharge, dispersal, seepage, migration, escape, release or exposure to any hazardous biological, chemical, nuclear radioactive weapon, device, material, gas, matter or contamination;
7. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft.

Pre-Existing Medical Condition Exclusion Waiver

The Pre-Existing Condition Exclusion will be waived if the protection plan is purchased within 14 days of the date the initial trip payment/deposit is received, and you are medically able and not disabled from travel at the time you pay for the plan, based on assessment of a physician.
