EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

This position is responsible for general assignment, television news reporting for OETA's weekly news program, the Oklahoma News Report as a Multi-Media Journalist. Primary responsibilities include:

- Produce a 5 6-minute news package weekly
- Identify and research story ideas
- •Schedule and Conduct On-Camera Interviews
- •Shoot interviews and B-Roll using Sony XD Cam 4K
- •Write Script and input script in the AP ENPS System
- •Edit story for broadcast on AVID editing system

Knowledge of State Governmental and Tribal affairs a plus.

This is **NOT** a "feature" reporting position.

The Oklahoma News Report focuses issues-oriented news that impacts state citizens.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

Bachelor's degree in journalism or related field required along with a minimum of two years' experience in reporting, writing, producing, and editing. Must be able to take personal initiative to develop stories that are consistent with the mission of the OETA News and Public Affairs Department and the Agency strategic plan. Must possess strong reporting, critical thinking, teamwork, and interpersonal skills and be a positive representative of OETA to the public and colleagues. Must be able to collaborate respectfully with photojournalists, graphic artists, producers, and news management to produce effective television news stories.
