RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conceptualize and creatively research, develop, and produce content, using lighting, camera, scripting, graphic creating, and non-linear editing techniques.
- Produce associated program content across multiple media platforms, including the OETA website, social media, and other avenues that develop.
- Write and archive script and promotional material associated with the program and assist others in archival and captioning of existing material.
- Participate in topic development for all department programs.
- Utilize photography and editing skills as needed with other OETA projects as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree in journalism or related field
- At least two years' experience in television or related field as a photographer/editor with writing skills or reporter with photography/editing skills. Must comprehend and utilize effective lighting and audio skills.
- Must be a creative editor and storyteller.
- Must be able to creatively operate contemporary HD camera equipment, and non-linear editing software (Premier and AVID preferred).
