



**Itinerary – Ice Age Fossils State Park Tour**  
**Thursday, October 23, 2025**

**Thursday, October 23** - Please wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing with sturdy shoes or boots. Dress in layers for temperature regulation, and protect your skin with sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses. The trail walk is ADA friendly.

TIME	ACTIVITY
<b>12:30 p.m.</b>	Meet at Vegas PBS, located at 3050 E. Flamingo Road (corner of Flamingo and McLeod). Come in the front door entrance located near the flagpoles to sign in. Boarding will start at 12:45 p.m.
<b>1:00 p.m.</b>	Deluxe motor coach departs for the Ice Age Fossils State Park.
<b>1:45 p.m.- 3:45 p.m.</b>	Arrive at the park and proceed to the Visitors Center where the ranger will welcome the group and take half the group on the .3 mile Megafauna trail walk to learn about the archeological discoveries in the area while the other half of the group learns about the fossils on display in the Visitors Center. When the first group returns (approximately 2:45 p.m.) the second group will go on the ranger-led trail walk while the first group learns about the fossils on display from extinct Ice Age mammals including the mammoth, giant ground sloth, saber-tooth cat and dire wolf.
<b>3:45 p.m.</b>	Depart Ice Age Fossils State Park.
<b>4:30 p.m.</b>	Estimated return arrival at Vegas PBS.
