



NUMBER CARD ACTIVITY SHEET



As you help your child get ready for kindergarten this summer, here are some recommended educational activities you can do with your child using the provided number cards.

CUTTING

Guide your child in cutting the letter cards on their own. These tips can help improve cutting skills:

- Keep the elbow on the table while cutting.
- Ensure the thumb stays on top. It can be helpful to put a sticker or mark on the part of the scissors where the thumb goes and instruct the child that they should be able to see it when they are cutting.

COOKIE COUNT

Begin with the side of the card that shows cookies. Encourage your child to touch and count each cookie. Once all the cookies are counted, flip the card and have your child say the number. If they get it wrong, turn the card back over and help them count the cookies again one by one.

DRAW THE NUMBER

Select a number from the deck. Ask your child to pick a simple image they enjoy drawing. Then, have your child draw that image as many times as the number on the card indicates.

EXERCISE AND COUNT

Pick a number from the deck and choose a fun exercise like jumping jacks, skipping, or toe touches. Have your child do the exercise as many times as the number on the card. Make it even more enjoyable by doing it together!

COOKIE ADDITION

Choose two cards from the deck. Start by discussing the number on each card to ensure your child knows them. Then, flip the cards to the cookie side. Say, "Now we are going to add these numbers together." Count all the cookies on both cards together to find the total. Finally, discuss the numbers you added. For example, "We started with a card that had two cookies and a card that had three cookies. When we counted all the cookies, there were five. That means 2 cookies plus 3 more cookies is 5 cookies altogether."

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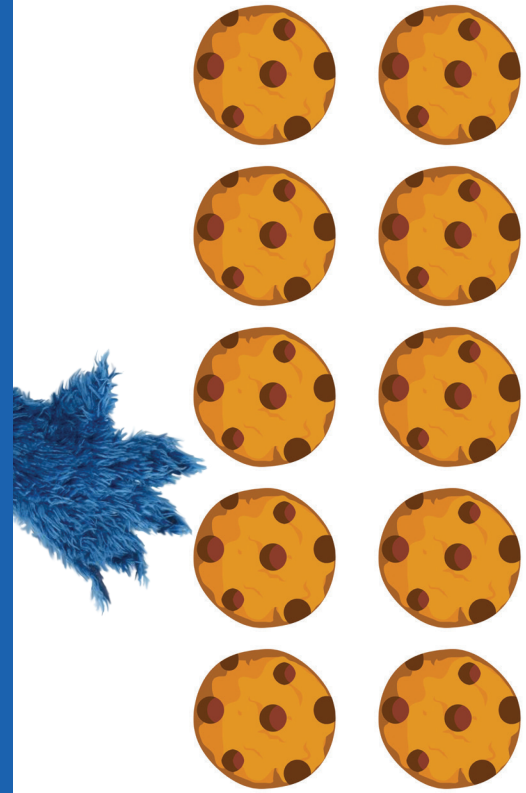
