



MARYLAND PUBLIC TELEVISION BETHLEHEM, PA - CHRISTMAS CITY, USA

Thursday, November 30 – Saturday, December 2, 2023

On Christmas Eve 1741, while a small group of Moravians were singing a hymn with the stanza "Not Jerusalem, Lowly Bethlehem" Count Nicolaus Ludwig Von Zinzendorf christened this little town "Bethlehem". Since that time Christmas in Bethlehem has been central to the city's identity. From the first documented decorated Christmas tree in America to today when both sides of the river boast Christmas markets filled with artisan craft, retail and food vendors, Bethlehem is filled with one Christmas celebration after another. So much so that the Hallmark Channel selected Bethlehem in 2022 as one of five towns in the U.S. to host a live stream of the city's historic downtown as part of their Countdown to Christmas.

ITINERARY

Day One – Departing from Maryland Public Television this morning, you will travel north to Bethlehem, PA. Upon arrival you will have free time for lunch on your own before we embark upon a walking tour of Old Bethlehem. A local guide in period dress will tell you how the city was settled by members of the Moravian Church and how Bethlehem residents lived and flourished during this time. Following the tour you'll visit the Central Moravian Church to view the Christmas Putz. A Moravian holiday tradition, the Putz (or Christmas Village) is an elaborate miniature-scale village that depicts various settings of the Nativity story through the use of hand-crafted figurines. After viewing the Putz, you will check into the Historic Hotel Bethlehem. Hotel Bethlehem has been named the #1 Best Historic Hotel in America and has a long history of gracious hospitality that has been enjoyed by former presidents, entertainers, sports legends and even the Dalai Lama. The hotel is located in the midst of the Historic Moravian District of Bethlehem, a designated National Historic Landmark District which has been nominated for UNESCO World Heritage Site status. This full service hotel is just steps from quaint shops, charming boutiques, museums and great dining. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. Following dinner, enjoy a Bethlehem By Night tour that explores the history and holiday traditions of Bethlehem. Sit back and experience the Christmas City on a trip back in time with a local guide aboard our motorcoach. This tour includes a visit to the famous star atop South Mountain, a look at early and current local holiday traditions, and access to historic highlights in north and south Bethlehem. **MEALS: DINNER**



Day Two – Enjoy a full hot buffet breakfast at the hotel this morning. Then, grab your holiday shopping list and you'll head to Christkindlmarkt, located on PNC Plaza at SteelStacks. Twice recognized as one of the best holiday markets in the U.S. by *Travel + Leisure*, this heart-warming holiday event features handmade works by some of the nation's finest artisans; Käthe Wohlfahrt, offering handmade ornaments, nutcrackers and collectibles from Germany; plus food vendors, live entertainment and much more festive fun! This afternoon return to downtown Bethlehem for some free time where you'll find shops offering gourmet foods, artwork, distinctive gifts, unique clothing, antiques, crafted beverages and holiday decorations. The Moravian Book Shop, the oldest bookstore in America, is a must-see. And don't forget the outdoor Christmas Village, charming, holiday-themed wooden huts that are filled with unique holiday gift ideas. All shopped out? Enjoy a carriage ride (fee not included) through this picture postcard town. Or relax and enjoy the amenities of the hotel. A buffet dinner is included at the hotel this evening.

Day Three – A full hot buffet breakfast is included this morning at the hotel. After checking out of the hotel, board the motorcoach and you'll head to Lancaster County, PA. GENERAL LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

Unless otherwise shown below, these exclusions apply to the Insured, the Insured's Traveling Companion, or Family Member scheduled and booked to travel with the Insured.

The following exclusion applies to the Trip Cancellation and Trip Interruption and Medical Expense:

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from a Pre-Existing Medical Condition, as defined in the plan.

The following exclusions apply to the Medical Expense benefits.

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from:

1. routine physical examinations or routine dental care;
2. traveling for the purpose or intent of securing medical treatment or advice;
3. Alcohol or substance abuse or treatment for the same;
4. Normal pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or childbirth, or elective abortion;
5. a Mental, Nervous or Psychological Condition or Disorder unless Hospitalized or Partially Hospitalized while the plan is in effect;
6. the Insured's participation in Adventure or Extreme Activities, riding or driving in races, or participation in speed or endurance competition or events, except as a spectator;
7. the Insured's participation in an organized athletic or sporting competition, contest, or stunt under contract in exchange for an agreed-upon salary or compensation. This does not include athletes participating in exchange for a scholarship or tuition.

The plan also contains exclusions specific to Baggage & Personal Effects and Baggage Delay.

In addition to any applicable benefit-specific exclusion, the following general exclusions apply to all losses and all benefits.

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from:

1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of the Insured, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner booked and scheduled to travel with the Insured, while sane or insane;
2. being under the influence of drugs or narcotics, unless administered upon the advice of a Physician as prescribed;
3. activities, losses, or claims involving or resulting from possession, production, processing, sale, or use of marijuana, illegal drugs, alcohol or substances are excluded from coverage;
4. war or act of war, including invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities between nations (whether declared or undeclared), or civil war;
5. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation by the Insured, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner;
6. directly or indirectly, the actual, alleged or threatened use, discharge, dispersal, seepage, migration, escape, release or exposure to any hazardous biological, chemical, nuclear radioactive weapon, device, material, gas, matter or contamination;
7. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft.

Pre-Existing Medical Condition Exclusion Waiver

The Pre-Existing Condition Exclusion will be waived if the protection plan is purchased within 14 days of the date the initial trip payment/deposit is received, and you are medically able and not disabled from travel at the time you pay for the plan, based on assessment of a physician.
