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





PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern













My friends and I are heading to the North Pole to see Santa and his elves.




We are busy packing our bags with food, water, books, hats, jackets, gloves, snow pants, animals, and toys.




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
Upon our arrival, we froze into ice people and stuck in one place.




The littlest elf was on a walk and with much surprise, saw us frozen.

"What do I do next?"




Then, he had an idea. He would call Santa to help!






Santa, with a surprised look, came to help. At once, he unfroze the visitors.
