





PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern








One day a girl named Kathran was walking home from the library and she saw a book on the sidewalk. "Wow!" said Kathran in disbelief.
"I bet no one will mind if I take this




book," she muttered to herself.


So she took the book to her house and started to read the book. One page after another that's when the book disappeared and there poor Kathran was now




standing by what seemed

the land looked different.




Different shades of pinks, greens, blues, and purple!

Kathran leaped out of her boat and said "Hi," but the ballerina




did not reply. So off Kathran went back to the boat. Then she saw the magical book again.

rudely crashed the




party! That's when the
