




PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern


my mom and me ever loved.

So I am going to the moon to find Maley and prove that she is real. I am going to find her.


Do you want to come with me?




First, I need to build a rocket ship. I got wires from a washing machine door and it took two days to build the whole thing.

I got into my rocket ship and started to go up. I went higher and higher until I reached the moon. I went around to see if there was any life on the moon. The plan was going great so far.




While I was looking around on the moon, I found a beautiful Kingdom that had lights and flying cars. I went to the castle and in the castle was Maley. She was beautiful.


