





PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern






Woof Woof!

the story is about to begin.




I was walking with my owner when my leash came off of my collar because I felt loud music, so I ran away.


Then, somehow I found myself in a forest.



I was so scared. I heard some noises from the bushes, so I hid behind a tree and saw two big black animals that happened to be a fox




and a bear. They looked so terrifying that I fainted.
When I woke up, I saw a wolf, then it tried to eat me. "Ahhh!" All of a sudden, the bear fought




off the wolf and the fox picked me up and took me somewhere safe. The bear finally came back. I said wondering, "Where am I?"




explained, "We saw you behind the tree looking frightened.
We decided to protect you since we scared you. So how did you get in this forest?"




asked the fox. I told them
