





PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern





"Aaa!" we screamed.




The pickle locked us in the pickle jar. At the very bottom of the jar there was the letter e.

When I saw the letter e,


I picked it up.

Next, we found the letter m.






My mom picked up the letter m. Then I found the letter e and picked it up. At the top of the jar, my mom found the letter r.






Then we found the letter i and the letter e.
