






PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern





handle and opened it. There






as suddenly as the door

started to run. She




had seen so many types of animals, it was as if there were as many in there as in the sky.

Ella looked up and saw even more books. She took the book. Then, she saw a woman sitting




in the corner of the library.
