






PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern




There was once a baby girl named Sun Hong Xuan.

Sometimes the ayis played with the orphans, but it was not the same as having a mommy, a daddy, and a brother and sister.









She suddenly had a brother and sister to play with, a mommy to cuddle, and a daddy to tickle her!


