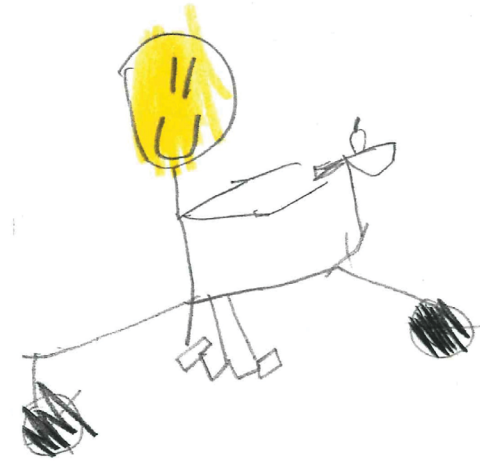

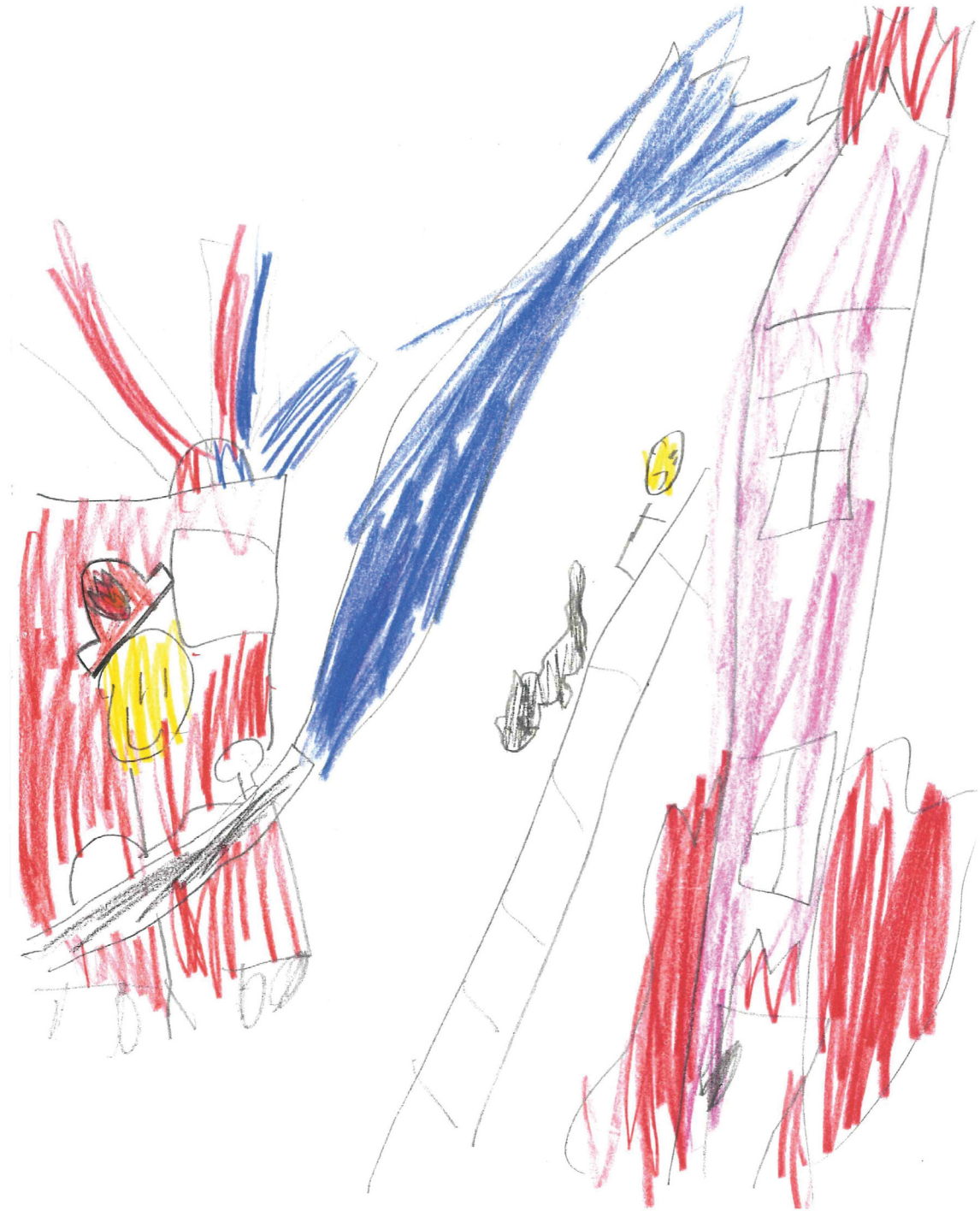
1 . Introduction

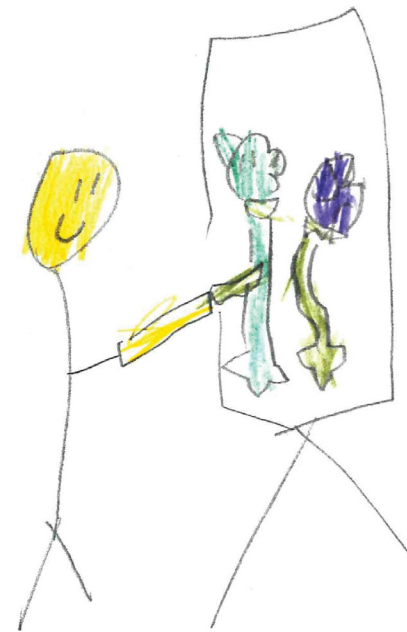
2 Firefighter

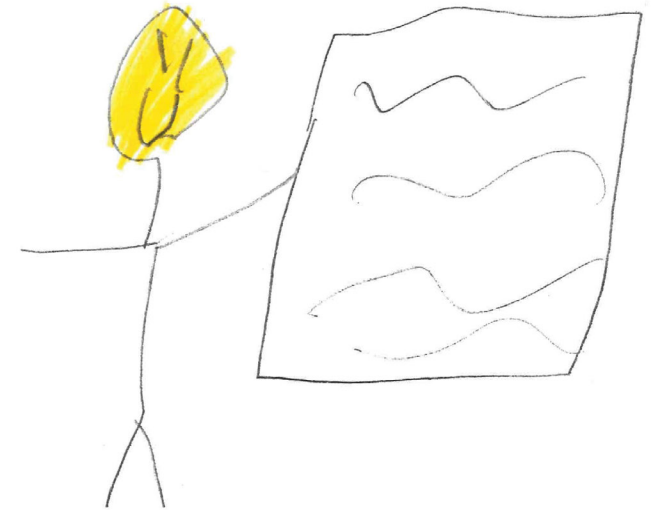
3. Artist
