Discover the story of the US Army's 23rd Headquarters Special Troops, known as the "Ghost Army," whose soldiers elevated battlefield deception to an art form during World War II. The unit consisted of a carefully selected group of artists, engineers, professional soldiers, and draftees, including famed artists such as fashion designer Bill Blass, painter Ellsworth Kelly, and photographer Art Kane. The unit waged war with inflatable tanks and vehicles, fake radio traffic, sound effects, and even phony generals – using imagination and illusion to trick the enemy while saving thousands of lives.

Armed with nothing heavier than .50 caliber machine guns, the unit participated in 22 large-scale deceptions in Europe and helped liberate Europe from the grip of Nazi tyranny.
