# GRAB THE PHONE BEFORE YOU GRAB THAT SHOVEL.

Whether you're planting a tree or planning a large home improvement project, the law requires you or your contractor to call 811 at least two days before digging in order to prevent damage to underground utility pipes and lines, and possible injury.

811 is a free service to help you identify underground utilities, since the depth of these lines varies and there may be multiple lines in a common area. Upon calling, a representative will come to the site of your dig and field mark the path of the underground facilities. You are required to mark in advance and in white the intended area of excavation.

Often, risky assumptions are made about whether to have utility lines marked, and digging into a pipe is the most common cause of a gas pipeline rupture. The homeowner or contractor who causes the damage is responsible for all repair costs, which average more than \$1,500.
