As of October 1, 2025, PBS Reno will no longer receive federal funding from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting. This loss directly impacts our budget through September 30, 2027—and beyond.



We are entering uncharted territory as we navigate the loss of \$1.3 million. This was crucial seed money that we planned to use toward programming, equipment, PBS dues, and many other expenses.
