Important Donor Information!

The holiday season is upon us and that reminds us the end of the calendar year is not far off. If you are planning some year-end charitable giving, qualified charitable distributions—QCDs for short —may make sense. QCDs are simply donations you make using funds from your traditional IRA. QCDs are more advantageous than ever for those over age 70½.



Here's how it works: instead of writing a check you transfer funds directly from your traditional IRA to

a qualified charity of your choice, like PBS Reno. No tax was paid on these funds when they went into the IRA, and by giving them to charity no tax is due on the amount given! Even better—if you are over age 73 and must take required minimum distributions (RMDs) from your IRA (which are often taxable), making a QCD results in a tax break while allowing you to give a generous gift to PBS Reno. Gifts like yours will help PBS Reno replace the \$1.3 million in federal funding that was taken away by Congress this year.

Remember—the funds must be transferred directly to PBS Reno from your IRA. If you transfer the money to your bank account and then write a check to us—you have lost your deduction.

Your financial advisor or the custodian of your IRA (Schwab, Fidelity, Vanguard for example) can assist you in this process. Discuss your options with them and then contact us at PBS Reno. We can assist you in making a year end gift that benefits you and our community.
