Nevada experienced its warmest winter on record, and many areas saw very little lasting snow—leaving more dry vegetation on the ground than usual. These hotter, drier conditions increase wildfire risk, making awareness and preparedness more important than ever.

At NV Energy, your safety is our number one priority. That's why we work year-round to strengthen our system, reduce fire risk, and protect the communities where we serve, live, and work.

How We Reduce Risk

To protect communities, we may use one or more of the following safety strategies:

■ Fire Season Settings

When fire danger is elevated, power lines in high-risk areas are switched to more sensitive settings. With these settings in place, the line will automatically shut off if something—such as vegetation or debris—comes into contact with it, reducing the likelihood of an ignition.

■ Public Safety Outage Management (PSOM)

A temporary, proactive shutoff during extreme fire risk to reduce the chance of equipment-related ignitions. These are forecasted in advance and customers will receive advance notification.

■ Emergency De-energization

As a last resort, NV Energy may turn off power if an active wildfire is threatening our equipment. This helps reduce the risk of our equipment contributing to or worsening an existing fire. For public safety, these shutoffs must be taken quickly, so customers may not receive advance notice.

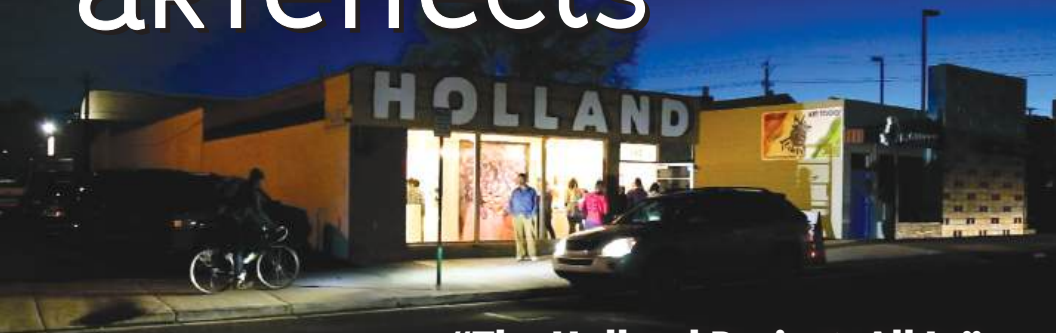

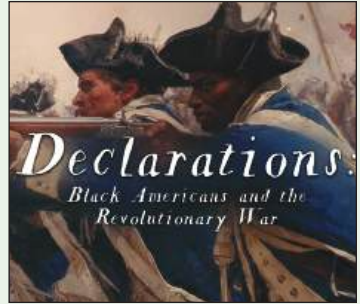
