THE SUMMER TRIANGLE IS AN ASTERISM, NOT A CONSTELLATION – IN FACT, THESE THREE STARS ARE PART OF THREE DIFFERENT CONSTELLATIONS!

VEGA IS THE TOP RIGHT CORNER OF LYRA THE HARP, ALTAIR IS THE NECK OF AQUILA THE EAGLE, AND DENEB IS THE TAIL OF CYGNUS THE SWAN.

THESE CONSTELLATIONS AND THE TRIANGLE ARE OUT EVERY NIGHT ALL SUMMER, SO PRACTICE SPOTTING IT.
