## WMHT 17.1 November 2024 Program Highlights

**A Final Landing On Iwo Jima:** A "then and now" look at the Japanese island at the heart of a brutal World War II battle. Follow a veteran of the 4th Marine Division as he returns to Iwo Jima for the final time. We also chronicle a son who has spent decades trying to get details of his father's time on Iwo, with little luck, so he, too, is returning to the island and trying to put his dad's wartime puzzle together. The documentary features many other interviews with Iwo Jima veterans.

### AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

**American Coup - Wilmington 1898:** the little-known story of a deadly race massacre and carefully orchestrated insurrection in North Carolina's largest city in 1898 — the only coup d'état in the history of the US.

**And Knowledge To Keep Us:** Every year at Cape Alitak on Kodiak Island in southern Alaska, Sugpiat kids gather for Akhiok Kids Camp to connect with each other and celebrate the knowledge their ancestors cultivated for more than 7500 years.

**Electric Indian:** A documentary from filmmaker Leya Hale, The Electric Indian follows Ojibwe hockey legend, Henry Boucha. A stand-out hockey star from Warroad, Minnesota, Boucha impressed on the ice from the 1969 Minnesota High School Hockey Tournament to the 1972 Olympics to the NHL, but an on-ice assault and injury ended his athletic career that unexpectedly led to a journey of healing and cultural reclamation.

### FRONTLINE

**China, The U.S. & The Rise Of Xi Jinping:** Tracing Xi Jinping's defining moments, how he's exercising his power and the impact on China and relations with the U.S.

**The Choice 2024 - Harris Vs. Trump:** A documentary investigating the lives and characters of Kamala Harris and Donald Trump as they seek the presidency.

### GREAT PERFORMANCES

**Henry Mancini 100 At The Hollywood Bowl:** Celebrate the centennial birthday of composer Henry Mancini with Michael Bubl , Cynthia Erivo and more.

**Land Of Gold:** The making of John Adams and Peter Sellars' "Girls of the Golden West," which dramatizes the history of the California gold rush.

**Patsy Cline Walkin' After Midnight:** Celebrating the life, legacy and music of country singer Patsy Cline with musical performances and commentary from fellow artists and those who knew her.

**Rogers And Hammerstein's 80th Anniversary:** Aaron Tveit, Patrick Wilson and more perform songs from musicals by Rodgers & Hammerstein including "Carousel," "South Pacific," "The King and I" and "The Sound of Music."

### INDEPENDENT LENS

**Make Peace Or Die:** After losing 17 men in his unit, Anthony Marquez dedicates himself to finding peace for himself and the families of the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines unit who served in Iraq.

**Inside The Court Of Henry VIII:** An investigation into the conspiracies and paranoia that plagued Henry VIII's court, such fears led to the execution of counsellors, friends and two of his wives.

**Leonardo Da Vinci:** A 15th century polymath of soaring imagination and profound intellect, Leonardo da Vinci created some of the most revered works of art of all time, but his artistic endeavors often seemed peripheral to his pursuits in science and engineering. Through his paintings and thousands of pages of drawings and writings, Leonardo da Vinci explores one of humankind's most curious and innovative minds.

**Lidia Celebrates America:** In this series of specials, Lidia Bastianich takes viewers on a culinary journey in which she explores how immigrants have preserved their unique culinary traditions, weaving their cultures into the diverse land that is America.

**Luna And Sofie:** Luna Kunath and Sophie Pohlmann work together to solve crimes.

### MASTERPIECE

**Marlow Murder Club:** Retired archaeologist and crossword setter Judith Potts believes that a brutal murder has taken place in the sleepy town of Marlow; when the police refuse to believe her story, she kicks off a private investigation with two unlikely friends.

**Nolly:** Exploring the reign, and fall from grace, of the inimitable Noele Gordon. With the boss's words all good things must come to an end ringing in her ears, Noele Gordon found herself thrown out of the show that was her life for over 18 years.

## WMHT 17.1 November 2024 Program Highlights

**Native Horse:** The history of the evolution of the horse in North America, exploring the horse-human connection throughout history to today.

**Native Waters:** The story of the Chitimacha, the 1,000-member tribe known as "the People of Many Waters" Journey into the Atchafalaya Basin with author Roger Stouff, son of the last chief of the Chitimacha Indians. Stouff shares native stories, beliefs, and perspectives about these often overlooked people while lamenting the demise of the river basin, the depletion of its sacred fishing and hunting grounds, and the painful "vanishings" of the time-honored Chitimacha way of life.

### NATURE

**Attenborough's Life Journey:** The episode follows Attenborough's life from his childhood as a fossil hunter to his work as a

BBC host and natural history presenter. It includes behind-the-scenes footage, interviews, and excerpts from his documentaries.

**Lions Of The Skeleton Coast:** Lion researcher Dr. Philip Stander follows three orphaned desert lion cubs as they navigate the harsh realities of survival in one of the world's most unforgiving places, Namibia's brutal Skeleton Coast.

**San Diego - America's Wildest City:** Following three animal families through the ups and downs of life in San Diego -- western grebes, California ground squirrels and harbour seals.

**Woodpeckers - The Hole Story:** Go deep into the woods to explore the lives of a unique avian family. Woodpeckers come in 239 species and live on every continent except Antarctica and Australia, playing a powerful role in every ecosystem they inhabit.

### NOVA

**Building Stuff:** Humans are the most innovative species on Earth. See how engineers are supercharging our abilities, reaching beyond our horizons, and altering our environment.

**Decoding The Universe:** See how our understanding of nature and the universe has been transformed since the 1970s.

**The Solar System:** The life of our solar system told in five dramatic stories spanning billions of years.

**Pelelieu - World War II's Most Preserved Battlefield:** The remote island of Pelelieu is considered the most well-preserved battlefield in the world – a living testament to one of the Marines' most bitter and eye-opening fights in World War II.

### POV

**The Body Politic:** In Baltimore, a young mayor fights to enact a bold plan to end chronic violence.

**Salute To Service:** An annual tradition to honor and salute the men and women who are serving or have served in the six official branches of our armed forces and their families.

### SECRETS OF THE DEAD

**Field Of Vampires:** The 2022 discovery in Eastern Europe of more than 50 errant burials that indicate a perceived threat of vampirism in the 17th century.

**Jamestown's Dark Winter:** Follows archaeologists and forensic anthropologists as they excavate the early American colony to uncover a dark secret hidden for more than 400 years.
