WMHT 17.1 April 2024 Program Highlights

A Brief History Of The Future Pt. 1/6 Beyond The Now: a unique six-part PBS documentary series about our futures and how we can reimagine them.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Poisoned Ground - The Tragedy At Love Canal: A piercing look back at an environmental disaster and the women who spoke up and fought for accountability.

Surviving The Dust Belt: The remarkable story of the determined people who clung to their homes and way of life, enduring drought, dust, disease — even death — for nearly a decade. Less well-known than those who sought refuge in California, typified by the Joad family in John Steinbeck's *The Grapes of Wrath*, the Dust Bowlers who stayed overcame an almost unbelievable series of calamities and disasters.

AMERICAN MASTERS

The Incomparable Mr. Buckley: Discover the intellectual evolution and political legacy of William F. Buckley, Jr. See how the author and commentator, one of the foremost public intellectuals in American history, galvanized the modern conservative movement.

An Above Average Day: Features longtime friends Ray O'Connor and Joe Murphy on their hiking and wilderness adventures while seeking answers the question: What could two men with a 30-year difference in age possibly have in common that would compel them to climb more than 400 mountains and hike in excess of 4,000 miles of trails?

Armenia - My Home: Experience spectacular aerial and ground views and cultural revelations of a country like no other in a virtual tour of Mount Ararat, Khor Virap, Yerevan, the Genocide memorial, and more.

Art Happens Here With John Lithgow: Actor John Lithgow goes back to high school to demonstrate the transformative power of arts education, exploring dance, ceramics, silk-screen printing and vocal jazz ensemble.

Big Sonya: For years, Sonia Warshawski (91) has been an inspirational public speaker at schools and prisons, where her stories of surviving the Holocaust as a teenager have inspired countless people who once felt their own traumas would leave them broken forever.

Changing Planet: In the third year of this 7-year project examining the issues facing the planet's most threatened ecosystems, Dr. M. Sanjayan visits the Maldives to take an in-depth look at coral reefs and the urgent efforts to help them survive climate change.

FRONTLINE

Crisis On Campus: A firestorm is raging on America's most prestigious campuses, ignited four months ago by the Hamas terror attack on Israel and the catastrophic war in Gaza, and now stirring up some of the most difficult and polarizing subjects in the country — antisemitism, DEI, leadership and accountability, and election year, culture war politics.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Now Hear This: Travel with host, Mexico City Philharmonic chief conductor Scott Yoo, in this special mini-series taking viewers on a voyage of musical discovery for aficionados and neophytes alike. Each episode reveals the creative process behind a diverse range of classical music in both historic and modern-day periods.

Greene Planet: In what could be described as 'Planet Earth from the perspective of plants', Sir David Attenborough travels the world to explore the extraordinary ways in which plants have learnt to survive and thrive in almost every environment.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Matter Of Mind: Three people face different paths as they live with the progressively debilitating illness ALS -- amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.

One With The Whale: An Alaskan family faces online attacks around their ancestral practices when animal activists target their son, the youngest person to ever harpoon a whale for his village.

Italy Made With Love: Travel the world with the Emmy-winning series to meet gifted artisans—from hat makers to harp makers—who pour passion and skill into timeless products made with love.

Julius Caesar - The Making Of A Dictator Pt. 1/3 High Priest: The dramatic story of how nearly five centuries of ancient Roman democracy was overthrown in just 16 years... by one man. This is the story of a brazen, ambitious power-grab that saw Julius Caesar consolidate the vast power of Rome in his own hands.

MASTERPIECE THEATER

Alice And Jack: Alice & Jack reveals how love plays out between two very different people over 15 years. The story explores the seminal question of whether the bonds between us are stronger than the forces that would tear us apart.

Guilt Season 3: The Edinburgh crime series bids farewell with the brothers reunited, career-best acting, and a plot that makes every single character face a life-defining crisis.

Mr. Bates Vs The Post Office: Shockingly true David vs Goliath story following one of the greatest miscarriages of justice in British legal history. When money started to seemingly disappear from its local branches, the government-owned UK Post Office wrongly blamed its own managers for the apparent loss. Hundreds were harassed, accused of theft and fraud, even sent to prison—leaving lives, marriages, and reputations in ruins. But the issue was actually caused by errors in the Post Office's own computer system; something it denied for years.

NATURE

Pandas Born To Be Wild: Observing pandas in the wild in China's Qinling Mountains; the training of a young panda born in captivity.

Raptors: Raptors are birds characterized by powerful talons and beaks, and keen vision that allows them to detect prey during flight.

Treasure Of The Caribbean: The discovery of a massive coral reef in Belize and Guatemala leads to a new chapter in understanding corals, the fish that depend on each other and the battle to save coral reefs around the world.

Next At The Kennedy Center: A dynamic mix of artists across hip hop, jazz, modern dance, and more perform at the Kennedy Center. Each episode weaves together performances filmed live at the Center with intimate off-stage moments contextualizing each artist's cultural impact.

NOVA

Ancient Maya Metropolis: An in-depth look at why the ancient Maya abandoned the cities they lived in for centuries.

Great American Eclipse: On April 8, 2024, millions of Americans will witness the rare event of a solar eclipse that will cross the continental United States. The Moon will block the Sun and reveal its corona in an incredible celestial spectacle.

Making North America: Mighty, elemental forces molded North America—fiery eruptions, titanic floods, the grinding of great ice sheets, and massive impacts from space all shaped our homeland. The epic three-part series unfolds in a forgotten world that existed long before our own, crossed by long-lost mountain ranges, deserts the size of Africa, and vast inland seas spanning the length of the continent.

Secrets Of The Forbidden City: The architectural design of Beijing's ancient complex of palaces and temples enabled it to survive centuries of earthquake shocks.

Opioids In New York - Stories And Solutions: WMHT joins with public media partners across New York State to examine the addiction and overdose crisis facing our state. The Overdose Epidemic brings together public media across the state to focus on a single issue across multiple platforms—broadcast television, radio, podcasts, online streaming, social media, live events, and more. Overdose Epidemic programming will continue to be produced and aired throughout 2023 and available to stream.

Reframing An Empire: Explore the life and work of Thomas Cole as he witnessed the birth of a new nation.

RFDS - Royal Flying Doctor Service: Based on remarkable real-life stories, this gripping drama series follows the modern-day heroes of the Royal Flying Doctor Service as they navigate private lives as turbulent and profound as the heart-stopping emergencies they attend to across some of the most beautiful and inhospitable places in the Australian outback.

Secrets Of The Dead: End Of The Romans: An investigation into the real causes of the decline of the Roman Empire, including three epidemics and climate change.

The 46ers: The 46ers is a feature film that captures the imagination and inspiration of those who make scaling the 46 Adirondack Mountain High Peaks in northern New York State a life-changing experience in their lives.

The Express Way With Dulé Hill: The Express Way with Dulé Hill documentary series that explores the power of the arts. Led by renowned actor, dancer, and singer, Dulé Hill, the series captures diverse artists' stories from across America, celebrating community, humanity, and the transformative potential of creative expression.

Wild Hope: WILD HOPE is a new series of short films that highlights the intrepid changemakers who are restoring our wild places and sparking new hope for the future of our planet.
