Age Of Nature: Explore humanity's relationship with nature and wildlife, as scientists and conservationists from all over the world examine ways we can restore our planet.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Boys Of '36: A group of working-class boys from the University of Washington, in the United States, surprise a nation when they capture the gold medal in rowing at the 1936 Summer Olympic Games in Berlin.

AMERICAN STORIES

The Outrage Of Danny Sotomayor: AIDS activist and political cartoonist Danny Sotomayor used civil disobedience to wage war on city officials who marginalized the LGBTQ community and ignored the AIDS crisis.

Benjamin Franklin: Ken Burns' four-hour documentary, Benjamin Franklin, explores the revolutionary life of one of the 18th century's most consequential figures

DI Ray: DI Ray follows DI Rachita Ray, played by 'The Blacklist' star Parminder Nagra, who is promoted to join a homicide investigation. However, she's told the murder is a 'Culturally Specific Homicide', which makes her suspect she's been chosen for her ethnicity rather than her ability.

Disco - Soundtrack Of A Revolution: A landmark, 3-part series that examines the rise – and fall – of disco, and celebrates its continuing musical and cultural legacy. The series will revel in iconic disco tracks and remarkable archive footage, analyzing and exploring the anthemic songs and sound they established. DISCO: SOUNDTRACK OF A REVOLUTION will reveal the surprising and overlooked history of disco.

Dynamic Planet: An epic journey, filmed over three years, to the extremes of all seven continents to meet an extraordinary group of people and animals on the front line of climate change. They reveal how science, nature and traditional knowledge can prepare us for a fast-changing future.

FRONTLINE

South Korea's Adoption Reckoning: An investigation into fraud and abuse in South Korea's foreign adoption boom, including falsified records and faked identities in the adoption of 200,000 children to the U.S. and other countries over seven decades.

Gods Of Tennis: Rebels, rockstars, revolutionaries. On court, they were legends. Off court, they challenged the world. Ashe, McEnroe, Borg, King, Navratilova, Evert - the golden age of tennis.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

A John Williams Premiere At Tanglewood: Composer John Williams returns to the Boston Symphony Orchestra's summer home at Tanglewood for a performance of his classical works as well as a new violin concerto for Anne-Sophie Mutter.

Hope In The Water: A three-part series highlights those who are working toward a sustainable future for the planet.

Hotel Portofino: The daughter of a wealthy industrialist moves to Italy in the 1920s to set up a quintessentially British hotel in the beautiful town of Portofino as Benito Mussolini's brand of fascism was on the rise.

Inside The Mind Of Agatha Christie: Surpassed only by the Bible and Shakespeare, Agatha Christie is the most successful writer of all time. We all know her characters and incredible plot twists, but what do we know about the Agatha herself? Combining rare access to Agatha's family, her personal archive and speaking to those who know her work best, we discover what made the world's most successful crime writer tick.

Lidia Celebrates America - Flavors That Define Us: In this series of specials, Lidia Bastianich takes viewers on a culinary journey in which she explores how immigrants have preserved their unique culinary traditions, weaving their cultures into the diverse land that is America.

NATURE

Attenborough And The Sea Dragon: Onsite extraction of fossils of an ichthyosaur, a fish lizard that ruled during the time of the dinosaurs, and a 3-D reconstruction of the creature; host David Attenborough.

Attenborough And The Giant Sea Monster: Sir David Attenborough investigates the discovery of a lifetime: the giant skull of a pliosaur. He joins two of the UK's most intrepid fossil hunters on their perilous expedition to excavate the skull from its resting place on a cliff face.

Australian Bushfire Rescue: The rescue, rehabilitation and eventual release of koalas, kangaroos, wombats and endangered species of parrots that survived the bushfires in Australia.

Big Bend - The Wild Frontier Of Texas: Wildlife in Big Bend National Park, including black bears; a roadrunner battles a rattlesnake in the desert; bats stalk the desert floor at night in search of scorpions.

Primates - Secrets Of Survival: The various species of primates, often referred to as the highest order of animal on the planet, include chimpanzees, gorillas and the snub-nosed monkey.

NOVA

Ancient Builders Of The Amazon: Discoveries reveal traces of ancient civilizations that flourished for centuries with prehistoric populations in the Amazon.

Emperor's Ghost Army: High-action experiments and 3-D technology provide insight into how China's terracotta army was made.

Forgotten Genius: The grandson of Alabama slaves, Percy Julian became an industrialist, self-made millionaire, humanitarian and civil rights pioneer.

Ice Age Footprints: A look at what thousands of prehistoric footprints in New Mexico's White Sands National Park might reveal about the peopling of the Americas.

Operation Bridge Rescue: The rebuilding of the 19th-century Blenheim covered bridge; traditional artisans in China restore ancient covered bridges.

Sunken Ship Rescue: Efforts to secure, raise and salvage the Costa Concordia cruise ship which capsized off the Italian coast on Jan. 13, 2012, killing 32 people.

POV

Against The Tide: Mumbai fishermen Rakesh and Ganesh are inheritors of the great Koli knowledge system—a way to harvest the sea by following the moon and the tides. Rakesh has kept faith in traditional fishing methods while Ganesh has embraced technology. Against the Tide is the tale of two men's bond fractured by the weight of a changing world and a sea threatened by climate change.

Hummingbirds: Silvia and Beba tell their own coming-of-age story, transforming their hometown on the Texas-Mexico border into a wonderland of creative expression and activist hijinks. Filmed collaboratively over the final summer of their fleeting youth, their cinematic self-portrait celebrates the power of friendship and joy as tools of survival and resistance.

Is There Anybody Out There: Born with a rare disability, filmmaker Ella Glendining wonders if there is anyone who can share the experience of living in a body like hers. This simple question—one which non disabled people take for granted, leads to a journey to not only others who live like her—but to the realization that meeting them changes how she views herself in the world, as well as many surprises along the way.

Professor T: Professor Jasper Tempest, a genius Cambridge University criminologist with OCD, unwittingly becomes an advisor to the police when he is caught up in a mysterious crime at the university. However, not all his new colleagues are enthusiastic.

Roots Of Comedy: Part comedy, part social commentary, host Jesus Trejo embarks on a journey across America meeting with six rising comedians who explore the mosaic of our nation through the lens of stand-up comedy.

Sea Change: SEA CHANGE uses the coastal regions of South Carolina and Georgia to exemplify the challenges of Climate Change, sea level rise, rising salinities, weather extremes and other changes that includes local, state, regional and national implications.

The Queen's Garden: A look at the grand ecosystem within the famed Queen's Garden, that spans across 39 acres. It homes a quarter of Britain's insect species, 200 wildflowers, and 42 bird species.

Through Our Eyes: From the producers of Sesame Street, THROUGH OUR EYES is an intimate and inspiring journey into the lives of American families from the perspective of children as they navigate formidable yet all-too-common challenges along with parents and siblings.
