## WMHT 17.1 September 2024 Program Highlights

**10 Modern Marvels That Changed America:** Host Geoffrey Baer takes viewers across the country to the legendary streets, monuments and man-made marvels that changed America. Explore the streets that change the way we get around, visit the Statue of Liberty and Mount Rushmore, and learn more about the engineering feats that made our civilization possible.

**Agatha Christie - Lucy Worsley On The Mystery Queen:** Lucy Worsley explores the enigma of Agatha Christie. Over three episodes, she applies her historian's powers of investigation to the Queen of Crime. And she uncovers a complex woman whose life – and work – reflects the upheavals of the 20th century.

### AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

**Sandra Day O'Connor The First:** Discover the story of the Supreme Court's first female justice. A pioneer who both reflected and shaped an era, Sandra Day O'Connor was the deciding vote in cases on some of the 20th century's most controversial issues—including race, gender and reproductive rights.

**Zoot Suits Riots:** Los Angeles erupts in violent riots after the trial for the murder of a Mexican-American youth in 1942.

### AMERICAN MASTERS

**Julia Alvarez - A Life Reimagined:** The work of author Julia Alvarez spans multiple genres and audiences, ranging from nonfiction and poetry to books for children and young adults and literary novels.

**Orozco:** Muralist José Clemente Orozco, a leader of the Mexican Renaissance, inspires President Franklin Roosevelt to hire painters to work on public walls during the Great Depression.

**Rita Moreno - Just a Girl Who Decided to Go For It:** Discover how Moreno defied her humble upbringing and racism to become one of a select group of Emmy, Grammy, Oscar and Tony Award winners. Explore her 70-year career with new interviews, clips of her iconic roles and scenes of the star on set today.

**Ancient Invisible Cities:** Professor Darius Arya explores the hidden secrets of three of the most fascinating cities of the ancient world: Cairo, Athens and Istanbul. 3D scans allow us to view the architectural jewels of these cities as they've never been seen before.

**Animals With Cameras:** Cameraman Gordon Buchanan works with scientists to put cameras onto animals, revealing unique footage and amazing discoveries about their lives.

**Big Cats:** In this thrilling new nonfiction series, produced in partnership with BBC & BBC Studios Natural History Unit, viewers will be transported to Botswana's wild Okavango Delta where a team of local and international filmmakers use the latest filming technology to follow lions, leopards and cheetahs day and night, revealing the lives of big cats like never before.

**Crossroads - A Conversation With America:** Judy Woodruff sits down with big thinkers to see what we've learned about America's divisions.

**Deadlock:** A dynamic new one-hour special aims to facilitate civil dialogue in an era dominated by polarizing debates. Moderated by Aaron Tang, professor at UC Davis School of Law, the series will feature a diverse panel of influential figures from legal, political, and cultural spheres delving into complex, ethical dilemmas based on real-life scenarios.

**Finding Tyler:** Tyler Johnson was a prized scholar in theoretical physics. Months later he was homeless on the island of Corsica, wanted by the FBI. Follow Tyler's loved ones as they try to piece together the final years of his life as he evaded the FBI on an island off the coast of France. Tyler's own words, and interviews with those who knew him best, explore the core struggle of life

**Lion - The Rise And Fall Of The Marsh Pride**: Explore the story of the Marsh pride of lions as it battles for survival in Kenya's Maasai Mara Reserve. In a world where lions and humans are increasingly at odds, the film charts the rise and fall of the pride. Featuring archival footage and testimony from those who have filmed the pride and lived alongside it, "Lion" is a powerful tale of shifting loyalties, complex family dynamics and more.

## MASTERPIECE

**Miss Scarlet And The Duke Season 4**: Miss Eliza Scarlet has taken over the business of Nash & Sons (not that he has any sons) and while things are not going entirely smoothly, help comes from some familiar sources. Outside of work, her relationship with William Wellington, aka the Duke, builds towards a looming decision that will shape both their lives.

**Moonflower Murders**: This six-part series is a sequel to Magpie Murders. Lesley Manville (World on Fire, Phantom Thread, Mrs. Harris Goes to Paris) and Tim McMullan (Patrick Melrose, Foyle's War) return in Moonflower Murders as editor turned amateur sleuth Susan Ryeland (Manville) and world-famous fictional detective Atticus Pünd (McMullan).

**Van Der Valk**: Follow a street smart and unapologetic Dutch detective as he navigates the lively and enigmatic city of Amsterdam, solving mysterious crimes using astute human observation and inspired detection.

## NATURE

**Pumas - Legends Of The Ice Mountains**: A puma mother of four cubs hunts and teaches her young how to survive in the massive mountains of Chile's Torres del Paine National Park.

## NOVA

**Eagle Power**: Up-close footage provides a look at the strength, eyesight and flying skills of an eagle, and reveals the danger and drama of chicks as they struggle to survive.

**Einstein's Quantum Riddle**: In an effort to disprove quantum mechanics, Albert Einstein proposes one of its strangest features: quantum entanglement.

## POV

**Name Me Lewand**: A deaf Kurdish boy's transformative journey to communicate through learning sign language.

**Who's Afraid Of Nathan Law?**: At 21, he was a leader of Hong Kong's Umbrella Revolution. By 23, he became Hong Kong's youngest elected lawmaker. At 26, he was Most Wanted under the National Security Law. *Who's Afraid of Nathan Law?* offers a close look at the city's most famous dissident to uncover what happens to freedom when an authoritarian power goes unchecked.

**Ridley**: Retired Detective Inspector Alex Ridley is called back to advise on a complex and compelling murder case by his replacement and former protégé DI Carol Farman. Carol is keen to access Ridley's unique insight into crime-solving which served them so well in the past, but the investigation takes a dark and unexpected twist.

**Southwestern Gems - Our Desert National Parks**: Stunning high-definition footage brings to life the majestic landscapes of The Great Basin Desert of Nevada and Utah; the Mojave Desert of California; the Sonoran Desert of Arizona; and the Chihuahuan Desert of New Mexico and Texas. The film captures the defining features and distinct character of each of these major desert areas. Experts from parks guide viewers through these natural treasures.

**TV Film**: 'TvFILM' is an engaging showcase for the creative works of a diverse regional community of independent filmmakers. 'TvFILM' also offers filmmakers in our area a chance to share their thoughts on the joys, struggles, tricks and trials of independent filmmaking.
