WMHT 17.1 March 2023 Program Highlights

Alpha Kappa Alpha - A Legacy Of Service: The 115-year history of one of the nation's oldest African American women's organizations is documented. Since its founding at Howard University in 1908, Alpha Kappa Alpha has facilitated national and international service initiatives for those in need.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Sandra Day-O'Connor The First: Discover the story of the Supreme Court's first female justice. A pioneer who both reflected and shaped an era, she was the deciding vote in cases on some of the 20th century's most controversial issues—including race, gender and reproductive rights.

The Movement And The Madman: Two antiwar protests in the fall of 1969 cause President Richard Nixon to cancel his "madman" plans for a massive escalation of the U.S. war in Vietnam.

The Vote: One hundred years after the passage of the 19th Amendment, The Vote tells the dramatic story of the hard-fought campaign waged by American women for the right to vote.

AMERICAN MASTERS

In The Making: This documentary from American Masters and Firelight Media follows eight emerging cultural icons on their journeys to becoming masters of their artistic disciplines.

Mae West - Dirty Blond: Dive into the life and career of groundbreaking writer, performer and subversive star Mae West. Over a career spanning eight decades, she broke boundaries and possessed creative and economic powers unheard of for a female entertainer in the 1930s.

Roberta Flack: follows the music icon from a piano lounge through her rise to stardom. From "First Time Ever I Saw Your Face" to "Killing Me Softly," Flack's virtuosity was inseparable from her commitment to civil rights.

Dr. Toni Fauci: Follows Dr. Fauci across fourteen months, showing a rarely seen side of this passionate scientist, husband, father and public servant as he battles a devastating pandemic while confronting a political onslaught that calls into question his 50-year career as this country's leading advocate for public health.

Burren Heart Of Stone: In the countryside of County Clare, Ireland, is the Burren, a mysterious place unlike anywhere else, with deep caves, a stony landscape, and ancient dolmens, ring forts, and castles.

Daniel O'Connell From Castlebar, Ireland: Join the beloved balladeer for a heartwarming concert from the T.F. Royal Theatre in Ireland. O'Donnell, one of Ireland's most popular folk singers, offers an Irish-country rendering of easy-listening tunes and inspirational favorites.

FRONTLINE

Age Of Easy Money: the two-hour documentary Age of Easy Money investigates how the Fed's experiment has changed the American economy and what it means that the era may be over.

Weinstein: An investigative report into the sexual harassment and misconduct allegations against film producer Harvey Weinstein and the efforts made to silence his accusers.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Remember This: This film, featuring a captivating performance from David Strathairn as the Polish resistance fighter Jan Karski, is a straightforward adaptation of the play of the same name.

The Conductor: Marin Alsop's quest to be the first female music director of a major symphony, featuring footage of her and mentor Leonard Bernstein set to a soundtrack of her performances.

Great Performances At The Met - The Hours: Renée Fleming makes her return to the Met in this new opera by from Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Kevin Puts, adapted from Michael Cunningham's novel, inspired by Virginia Woolf's "Mrs. Dalloway." The opera follows three women from different eras who each grapple with inner demons and their roles in society.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Hidden Letters: For centuries in China, the once-secret written language of Nüshu was calligraphed on folded fans and handkerchiefs as hidden letters so women could share stories and express solidarity.

Storming Caesar's Palace: Chronicles the life of Ruby Duncan, an activist who fights the welfare system and ends up a White House advisor. She led a grassroots movement of mothers who challenged Presidents, the Vegas Mob, and everyday Americans to rethink their notions of the "Welfare Queen."

Irish Dance - Steps Of Freedom: A look at the evolution of Irish dance, from its origins to its mix with other cultures.

Isabel And Roy: Prior to his Pop-art fame in New York, Roy Lichtenstein struggled to find work and raised a family in Cleveland. His wife Isabel helped support him as he developed his signature style. But, before he could establish his career, she had to give up hers.

Kasturba Gandhi - Accidental Activist: The story that has never been fully told . . . Kasturba Gandhi lived alongside one of the greatest men in history, but she has remained in his shadow—now she emerges. Gandhi himself said she taught him about nonviolence and called her “his precious jewel” of inspiration.

Les Miserables - The Staged Concert: Les Misérables is a French historical novel by Victor Hugo, first published in 1862, that is considered one of the greatest novels of the 19th century. Les Misérables has been popularized through numerous adaptations for film, television and the stage, including a musical.

Marie Antoinette: Marie Antoinette is just a teenager when she leaves Austria to marry the Dauphin of France. At Versailles, under the complex rules of the French court, she suffers from not being able to live her life the way she wants.

NATURE

Born In The Rockies: Journey deep into the wild heart of the Rocky Mountains and experience this rugged land through the eyes of its iconic wildlife.

The Egg, Life's Perfect Invention: Join Sir David Attenborough to reveal the incredible egg, piece by piece, from creation to hatching.

The Mighty Weasel: Discover the truth about the infamous weasel family, often portrayed as villains and associated with unsavory behavior. Follow the adventures of first-time weasel mom Bandita, raising her kits in a unique garden, and meet tiny but mighty orphan weasel Twiz on her journey back to the wild.

The Serengeti Rules: Travel back in time, from the Arctic Ocean to Pacific tide pools, with a pioneering group of scientists who make surprising discoveries that transform human understanding of nature and ecology. They discovered that a single set of rules that govern all life.

Neanderthal: This two-part series investigates what our ancient ancestors looked like and what would have happened when we met them. It turns out that what we thought we knew about them is wrong.

Ancient Maya Metropolis:
