<u>Reframing An Empire</u>: A reflection on historic interpretation and representation throughout this series. We check in with historians and curators on why it is important to take into account a critical lens and students of our history.

<u>Repairing The World - Stories From The Tree Of Life</u>: Pittsburgh's community response to hate following the assault on three congregations at the Tree of Life synagogue in 2018.

<u>Roadtrip Nation</u>: Follow the journeys of groups of people as they travel across the country in a green RV, sit down with professionals who share their interests, and gain insight into what it takes to overcome struggle and find personal success. <u>Rooted Out - Repairing The World</u>: On October 27, 2018, the three congregations worshipping at Pittsburgh's Tree of Life synagogue were attacked in the deadliest anti-Semitic assault in U.S. history. Eleven people were killed that day as the Jewish community in Pittsburgh and around theworld found themselves facing a resurgence of age-old threats that have led to so much horrific violence. In Repairing the World, director Patrice O'Neill respectfully and sensitively documents the response of the community in the aftermath of this tragic event.

SECRETS OF THE DEAD

Eiffel's Race To The Top: Discover the untold story of Paris' most famous landmark and the race to top 1,000 feet.

Jurassic Fortunes: Discover the world of dinosaur fossil collecting, an unusual hobby with a growing market.

<u>The Sunken Basilica</u>: Uncover the sunken remains of a 4th-century basilica in western Turkey. Submerged beneath the waters of Lake Iznik for hundreds of years, the church could reveal crucial insights into the early days of Christianity.

Singing Our Way To Freedom: A chronicle of the life and music of Ramon "Chunky" Sanchez

<u>The Addict's Wake</u>: Examines drug addiction in Brown County. The Brown County Sheriff's department says 2020 saw a record number of drug overdose calls. A documentary is shining a new light on the fight against addiction.

The American Buffalo A Story of Resilience: Judy Woodruff moderates a one-hour conversation with filmmaker Ken Burns and three experts: Jason Baldes, Rosalyn LaPier, and Dan Flores. The discussion explores lessons from the film - the early history and special relationship between native American people and the buffalo; its relation to the larger grassland and prairie ecosystems; and Tribal contributions to restoration of the buffalo today.

<u>The Path Forward - Remembering Willowbrook</u>: In 1972, Geraldo Rivera produced an exposé on the Willowbrook State School in Staten Island, shocking the nation and forever changing the treatment of people with disabilities in the state and across the country.
