WMHT 17.1 May 2024 Program Highlights

A Final Landing On Iwo Jima: A “then and now” look at the Japanese island at the heart of a brutal World War II battle.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Surviving The Dust Bowl: The remarkable story of the determined people who clung to their homes and way of life, enduring drought, dust, disease — even death — for nearly a decade.

The Riot Report: In 1967, President Lyndon B. Johnson appointed the Kerner Commission to investigate why Black neighborhoods all over the country were “rioting” in protest. He was blindsided by the findings, which blamed the government for race-exclusive policies that fomented poverty, housing crises, unemployment, and discrimination. The film commemorates the landmark report and hints at lessons for a world where racism continues to be a divisive, damaging force.

Asian Americans: A five-hour film series that will chronicle the contributions, and challenges of Asian Americans, the fastest-growing ethnic group in America.

Burren Heart Of Stone: In the countryside of County Clare, Ireland, is the Burren, a mysterious place unlike anywhere else, with deep caves, a stony landscape, and ancient dolmens, ring forts, and castles. The two-part documentary series The Burren: Heart of Stone, narrated by award-winning Irish actor Brendan Gleeson, unveils the secrets hidden in the stones of this dramatic wind-

Changing Seas: Changing Seas gives viewers a fish-eye view of life in the deep blue. Join scientists as they study earth’s last frontier and discover the mysteries of our liquid planet.

D-Day At Pointe Du Hoc: The remarkable story of the U.S. Army’s 2nd Ranger battalion. Led by Lt. Col. James Earl Rudder, the soldiers scaled the 100-foot cliffs of Pointe-du-Hoc in Normandy on June 6, 1944. Featuring interviews with surviving veterans from the Pointe-Du-Hoc assault, the film shares an incredible story of adversity and courage from World War II.

Going To War: What is it really like to go to war? Filled with terror, pain and grief, it also brings exhilaration, and a profound sense of purpose. In Going to War, renowned authors Karl Marlantes and Sebastian Junger help us make sense of this paradox and get to the heart of what it’s like to be a soldier at war. Veterans of various conflicts reveal some universal truths of combat with unflinching candor.

Golden Eagles - Witnesses To A Changing West: “Golden Eagles: Witnesses to a Changing West” takes you in the field with eagle researchers in Wyoming as they strive to discover how the birds are adapting to the many challenges facing them, climate change to sprawl, lead poisoning, energy development. Rappel into eagle nests; go behind the scenes at wildlife rehabilitation centers; hear stories of Indigenous peoples’ connections to the eagle.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Audra McDonald: Winner of five Tony Awards and two Grammys, singer and actress Audra McDonald sings “Dear Friend” (from the musical “She Loves Me”) for the Great Performances 40th Anniversary Celebration at Lincoln Center in New York City.

Hamlet: Experience this contemporary opera based on Shakespeare’s masterpiece directed by Neil Armfield and composed by Brett Dean. Starring Allan Clayton in the title role, mezzo-soprano Sarah Connolly as Gertrude, and baritone Rod Gilfry as Claudius.

Now Hear This: Travel with host, Mexico City Philharmonic chief conductor Scott Yoo, in this special mini-series taking viewers on a voyage of musical discovery for aficionados and neophytes alike. Each episode reveals the creative process behind a diverse range of classical music in both historic and modern-day periods.

Purlie Victorious: The comedic play tells the story of a Black preacher’s scheme to reclaim his inheritance and win back his church from a plantation owner.

Green Planet - Human Worlds: Sir David Attenborough reveals how humans are helping plants, many of which face extinction.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Space - The Longest Goodbye: NASA psychologists prepare astronauts for the extreme isolation required by a Mars mission.

Space - The Tuba Thieves: What is the role of sound and what does it mean to listen? Hard of hearing filmmaker Alison O’Daniel uses a series of tuba thefts in Los Angeles high schools as a jumping-off point to explore these questions. Through several d/Deaf people telling stories in a unique game of telephone, the central mystery of The Tuba Thieves isn’t about theft of instruments; it’s about the nature of sound itself.

WMHT 17.1 May 2024 Program Highlights

LUCY WORSLEY INVESTIGATES

Princess In The Tower: Lucy Worsley uncovers the story of the two boys whose disappearance in 1483 has led to centuries of mystery and speculation.

The Madness Of King George: Lucy Worsley investigates how George's mental illness changed Britain. She uncovers royal papers and explores how the attempt on his life by a mentally ill subject changed psychiatry forever.

MASTERPIECE THEATER

Maryland: follows two estranged sisters who reunite to unearth the truth about their mother's sudden death and her double life on the Isle of Man. This is not so much a murder mystery as a compelling tale of two siblings opening up to each other as they work out a string of family secrets.

NATURE

Green Island - White Desert: Ireland is renowned worldwide for its lush green landscapes and wild Atlantic coast, but one of its greatest natural treasures is a desert of grey stones called the Burren, which is home to some of Ireland's most enchanting wildlife.

Grizzly - Queen Of The Tetons: The most famous bear in the Tetons attempts to raise four cubs. But she makes increasingly unexpected and consequential choices to protect her family, Grizzly 399 stands as a symbol of the clash between humans and the wild.

Niagara Falls: Embark to Niagara Falls and witness its stunning beauty and a wide variety of wildlife—mammals, birds, and reptiles—that call it home. Through the eyes of passionate scientists, uncover a complex world forged by stone and powered by water.

Saving The Animals Of Ukraine: A new nature reserve is being established in Western Ukraine to provide a safe refuge for rescued wildlife.

Season Of The Osprey: Cameraman Jacob Steinberg captures the struggles, failures and triumphs of an osprey family over the course of five years.

Next At The Kennedy Center: A dynamic mix of artists across hip hop, jazz, modern dance, and more perform at the Kennedy Center. Each episode weaves together performances filmed live at the Center with intimate off-stage moments contextualizing each artist's cultural impact.

NOVA

Decoding The Universe: How big is the universe? Will it ever end? Why is so much of it made of mysterious dark matter and energy? See how mind-bending discoveries over the past 50 years have revolutionized our understanding of the universe.

Making North America: Mighty, elemental forces molded North America—fiery eruptions, titanic floods, the grinding of great ice sheets, and massive impacts from space all shaped our homeland. The epic three-part series unfolds in a forgotten world that existed long before our own.

Secrets Of Your Data: Alok Patel takes a look at what happens to the personal data shared on social media and efforts to maximize benefits without compromising personal privacy.

Why Bridges Collapse: The 2018 collapse of a section of the Morandi Bridge in Genoa, Italy; bridge collapses in the U.S.; engineering techniques that can make bridges safer and prevent them from breaking down.

Why Ships Crash: The investigation into how the Ever Given container ship crashed into the Suez Canal in March 2021, causing a major supply chain crisis around the globe.

Photographic Justice - The Corky Lee Story: Chinese American photographer Corky Lee documents the celebrations, struggles and daily lives of Asian American and Pacific Islanders, assembling an astonishing archive of nearly one million images.

Pompeii - The New Dig: Tracking new discoveries made at the ancient Italian archaeological site, the 3×60' series will interweave the finds with the stories of people who lived there.

The Express Way With Dule Hill: Led by renowned actor, dancer, and singer, Dulé Hill, the series captures diverse artists' stories from across America, celebrating community, humanity, and the transformative potential of creative expression.

Through Our Eyes: From the producers of Sesame Street, THROUGH OUR EYES is an intimate and inspiring journey into the lives of American families from the perspective of children as they navigate formidable yet all-too-common challenges along with parents and siblings.
