Operation Bridge Rescue: The rebuilding of the 19th-century Blenheim covered bridge; traditional artisans in China restore ancient covered bridges.
Odysseus Returns: An amateur historian, Makis Metaxas, claims he found the bones of Odysseus, the hero of Homer's epic poem, the Odyssey. But the discovery is soon embroiled in controversy, and Makis embarks on his own odyssey to convince the world he is right.
POV
Fauna: Set in a rural area in the outskirts of Barcelona, Pau Faus's keen-eyed, witty and compassionate second documentary Fauna... juxtaposes the life of a local goatherd and life in a nearby research laboratory to explore the tangled contemporary relationship between man, nature and science.
Sea Change: SEA CHANGE uses the coastal regions of South Carolina and Georgia to exemplify the challenges of Climate Change, sea level rise, rising salinities, weather extremes and other changes that includes local, state, regional and national implications.
Straight No Chaser: A cappella group Straight No Chaser, formed 25 years ago at Indiana University, have sold more than three million albums, more than 1.5 million concert tickets, and garnered over a billion streams. They returned to Indiana to tape this concert at the Murat Theatre, performing classics like "Proud Mary" and "Lean on Me" as well as contemporary songs like "I'm Yours" and "All About That Bass."
VOCES - Almost American: In 2018, the Department of Homeland Security terminated Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for almost all TPS holders -- foreign nationals from countries beset by civil unrest, violence, or natural disaster who are permitted lawful residence in the United States, the majority of whom are from El Salvador, Honduras, and Haiti. The decision left American families on the brink of a family separation crisis -- not on the border, but in communities across the United States.
Wild Metropolis: Discover the extraordinary animals adapting to life in the world's most loved cities, and witness the remarkable ways they meet the challenges of surviving in the newest habitat on the planet.
