AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Roberto Clemente: An in-depth look at an exceptional baseball player and committed humanitarian who challenged racial discrimination to become baseball's first Latino superstar.

The American Vice President: What happens when the president is unable to serve? Explore the dramatic period between 1963 and 1976, when a grief-stricken, then scandal-stricken America was forced to define the role of the vice president and the process of succession.

Big Cats: In this thrilling new nonfiction series, produced in partnership with BBC & BBC Studios Natural History Unit, viewers will be transported to Botswana's wild Okavango Delta where a team of local and international filmmakers use the latest filming technology to follow lions, leopards and cheetahs day and night, revealing the lives of big cats like never before.

Citizen Nation: The four-part program is an inspiring coming-of-age story that follows teenagers from across the US with diverse personal and political backgrounds.

Confluence: Confluence explores the enduring--and often surprising connections between three of the most essential aspects of the human experience: art, science, and creativity.

FRONTLINE

A Year Of War - Israelis And Palestinians: The horrifying accounts of living through the Hamas attack and the war in Gaza. Told by the people directly impacted on both sides of the conflict, the death, despair and ongoing trauma.

American Voices 2024: Following the changing views and experiences of Americans from the 2020 election to today. Returning

to voters filmed four years ago, to see how their hopes and fears have changed amid another polarizing election season.

The VP Choice - Vance Vs. Walz: Investigating the lives and views of JD Vance and Tim Walz as they run for vice president. In an historic election, those who know the candidates best reveal the influences and ideas they'd bring to the White House.

Geraldine Ferraro - Paving The Way: The trailblazing Vice-Presidential nominee helped change the face of American politics when she became the first female nominee for national office by a major party. Geraldine Ferraro's journey from an impoverished childhood to her great accomplishments are captured in interviews with political giants and contemporaries, and her last interview before she died at age 75.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Émigré: An international cast joins the New York Philharmonic for the American premiere of Emigre, a semi-staged oratorio that tells an unusual story of Jewish refugees during World War II.

MASTERPIECE

Marlow Murder Club: Retired archaeologist and crossword setter Judith Potts believes that a brutal murder has taken place in the sleepy town of Marlow; when the police refuse to believe her story, she kicks off a private investigation with two unlikely friends.

Moonflower Murders: This six-part series is a sequel to Magpie Murders. Lesley Manville (*World on Fire*, *Phantom Thread*, *Mrs. Harris Goes to Paris*) and Tim McMullan (*Patrick Melrose*, *Foyle's War*) return in *Moonflower Murders* as editor turned amateur sleuth Susan Ryeland (Manville) and world-famous fictional detective Atticus Pünd (McMullan).

Van Der Valk: Follow a street smart and unapologetic Dutch detective as he navigates the lively and enigmatic city of Amsterdam, solving mysterious crimes using astute human observation and inspired detection.

Wolf Hall: Starring Damian Lewis, Mark Rylance and Claire Foy, this series is a six-part adaptation of Hilary Mantel's novels 'Wolf Hall' and 'Bring Up the Bodies'. The historical drama follows the story of Thomas Cromwell through his rise in social hierarchy. From his humble beginnings as a blacksmith's son, Cromwell becomes King Henry VIII's chief minister. The episodes chronicle his life as he deals with the power struggles of the Tudor Court and a king who has difficulty producing a male heir.

Moments To Remember: Patti Page and Nick Clooney co-host new performances and archival classics from the vault.

WMHT 17.1 October 2024 Program Highlights

NATURE

Dracula's Hidden Kingdom: A family of mouse-eared bats struggle to bring up their young in the ruined walls of Transylvania in central Romania.

Super Cats: How big cats survive and thrive around the globe, from the solitary bachelor snow leopard in the Himalays to the swamp tiger of South Asia.

The Bat Man Of Mexico: David Attenborough narrates the story of Rodrigo Medellín, Mexico's very own 'Bat Man'. Since he first kept vampire bats in his bathroom as a child, Rodrigo has dedicated his life to saving them. Now Mexico's most famous export, tequila, is at stake.

The Serengeti Rules: In the 1960s, a small band of scientists discovered a single set of rules that govern all life. Now they tell their stories, and reveal how their work gives us a chance to reimagine the world.

NOVA

The Solar System: The life of our solar system told in five dramatic stories spanning billions of years.

Opioids In NY - Stories And Solutions: Examines the complex landscape of addiction, explores harm reduction strategies, and discusses comprehensive efforts in New York to address the opioid epidemic.

POV

In The Rear View: In a volunteer aid van occupied by multiple generations of civilians, an authentic, intimate observation of the war in Ukraine unfolds.

Twice Colonized: Inuit activist Aaju Peter embarks on a personal journey for Indigenous people's rights.

Ridley: Retired Detective Inspector Alex Ridley is called back to advise on a complex and compelling murder case by his replacement and former protégé DI Carol Farman. Carol is keen to access Ridley's unique insight into crime-solving which served them so well in the past, but the investigation takes a dark and unexpected twist.

SECRETS OF THE DEAD

Field Of Vampires: The 2022 discovery in Eastern Europe of more than 50 errant burials that indicate a perceived threat of vampirism in the 17th century.

Mozart's Sister: Why Wolfgang Mozart's sister Maria Anna, his musical partner and collaborator, was forced to withdraw from public life and what happened to her music.

Returning To Babylon: A team of archaeologists search for Assyrian artifacts that survived the Isis occupation of Mosul, including clues to a possible location of the Hanging Gardens of Babylon.

The Civil War's Lost Massacre: Historians, descendants and archaeologists search for information about the deaths and lost burial site of more than 20 Black Civil War soldiers.

The Herculaneum Scrolls: Computer scientist Brent Seales attempts to read inside hundreds of carbonized ancient scrolls found at the archaeological site of Herculaneum in Italy.

The Jewish Journey: Trace Jewish immigration to the US through the centuries. Interviews with top scholars in Jewish history, notable Jewish-American writers, and many immigrants themselves detail the varied stories of migration through the last five centuries, with a rarely explored look at the actual journeys to get here.

VOCES

American Historia: New three-part series follows award-winning actor and producer John Leguizamo on his continued quest to uncover the fascinating history and often overlooked contributions of Latino people.

Latino Vote 2024: Examining a range of election-related issues that matter most to the Latino community in battleground states; the role of Latino evangelical pastors in shaping community perspectives.

Mambo Legends: The Mambo Legends Orchestra is committed to keeping the sounds of the great Afro-Cuban bandleaders Machito, Tito Puente, and Tito Rodríguez alive for future generations.

Our Texas Vote: On the eve of the upcoming presidential election, acclaimed filmmaker Hector Galán takes viewers inside the largest Latino voter registration mobilization in Texas history, led by a new generation on the frontlines of a growing swing state that neither political party can ignore.
