WMHT 17.1 January 2024 Program Highlights

88th Annual Anisfield-Wolf Book Awards: The Anisfield-Wolf Book Awards recognize books that have made important contributions to our understanding of racism and human diversity.

American Buffalo: A two-part, four-hour series, takes viewers on a journey through more than 10,000 years of North American history and across some of the continent's most iconic landscapes, tracing the animal's evolution, significance to the Great Plains, near demise, and relationship to the Indigenous People of North America.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Nazi Town USA: The largely unknown story of this organization that had chapters across the country and represented what experts believe was a 'very real threat of fascist subversion in the United States.' Organized into 70 different districts, the Bund held joint rallies with the Ku Klux Klan and ran dozens of summer camps for children centered around Nazi ideology and imagery.

AMERICAN MASTERS

Hopper - An American Love Story: A look into artist Edward Hopper's work, life and relationships, including his early career as an illustrator and his critical and commercial acclaim.

America's Home Cooking - When In Rome: Chris Fennimore and company present a tour of authentic recipes from Rome, featuring everything from caprese salad to easy beef straccetti.

Benjamin Franklin: Ken Burns' four-hour documentary, Benjamin Franklin, explores the revolutionary life of one of the 18th century's most consequential figures.

Citizen's Guide To Preserving Democracy: A Citizen's Guide to Preserving Democracy is based on Dr. Richard Haass' best-selling book "The Bill of Obligations: The Ten Habits of Good Citizens." Through interviews and real-life examples, Hari Sreenivasan and Dr. Haass explore how Americans are working towards strengthening democracy and renewing the spirit of a more informed and engaged citizenry.

Cost Of Inheritance: An America Reframed special, explores the complex issue of reparations in the U.S. using a thoughtful approach to history, historical injustices, systemic inequities, and critical dialogue on racial conciliation.

Dream School - A Dream To Higher Education: the inspiring journey of six bright and ambitious high school students working to get admitted into America's top colleges. Their stories and the advice of nationally-respected higher ed and mental health experts will help families better understand the college admission process.

FRONTLINE

Democracy On Trial: A look at the roots of the criminal cases against Donald Trump arising from his 2020 election loss.

Israel's Second Front: An investigation into militants in the West Bank and Lebanon, their ties to Iran and their role in the conflict between Israel and the Palestinians.

How Saba Kept Singing - Holocaust Remembrance: Musician David "Saba" Wisnia believed that he survived the horrors of Auschwitz by entertaining the Nazi guards with his beautiful singing voice. Join David and his grandson Avi as the pair embark on a journey exploring the mystery of Saba's past.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Beyond Utopia: Stories of families attempting to escape oppression in North Korea.

Racist Trees: Racial tensions reignite as a historically Black neighborhood in Palm Springs, Calif., continues to fight for the removal of a wall of trees that may have been planted as a totem of segregation.

Razing Liberty Square: Liberty City, Miami, was home to one of the oldest segregated public housing projects in the U.S. Now with rising sea levels, the neighborhood's higher ground has become something else: real estate gold. Wealthy property owners push inland to higher ground, creating a speculators' market in the historically Black neighborhood previously ignored by developers and policy-makers alike.

Kennedy And Albany - A Writer And His City: Discover the life and legacy of William Kennedy as told by the Pulitzer Prize-winning author himself. In this intimate documentary, learn about Kennedy's humble beginnings in his hometown of Albany, which would become the backdrop and fodder for much of his work, and his incredible career spanning nearly five decades.

NATURE

Big Little Journeys: Dive into the worlds of six tiny animals on the greatest adventures of their lives.

Gorilla: They are ground-dwelling, predominantly herbivorous apes that inhabit the forests of central Africa. The genus is divided into two species.

Primates - Secrets To Survival: Discover the survival strategies used by primates, often in the most unexpected places.

The Serengeti Rules: In the 1960s, a small band of scientists discovered a single set of rules that govern all life. Now they tell their stories, and reveal how their work gives us a chance to reimagine the world.

NOVA

Arctic Drift: Scientists embark on a research expedition in the Arctic that brings clarity to predictions of global change.

High Risk - High Rise: This episode looks at how building engineers have in the past looked at safety issues involving skyscrapers, and what is done to continue this into the future.

Iceman Reborn: New discoveries about Otzi the iceman, the oldest human mummy on Earth, reveal details about the dawn of civilization in Europe.

Ultimate Space Telescope: NASA's James Webb Space Telescope, from its conception to completion.

When Whales Could Walk: Paleontologists uncover a whole new species of whale in a parched valley not far from Cairo.

POV

Brief Tender Light: At the elite MIT, a Ghanaian alum follows four African students striving to become agents of positive change back home. Even as their dreams are anchored in the societies they left, their daily realities are defined by America. Each must refine their ideas about the world and about themselves, and ultimately, how to transform youthful ideals into action as adults.

SECRETS OF THE DEAD

Ben Franklin's Bones: When the skeletal remains of at least ten people turned up in the basement of Benjamin Franklin's London residence, people wondered if he had a much darker side, prompting an investigation into a very cold case.

Hannibal In The Alps: Explorers, archaeologists and scientists combine technology and ancient texts to prove that Hannibal's army crossed the Alps to launch an attack on Rome.

Jamestown's Dark Winter: Archaeologists excavating the site of an early American colony discover the remains of a young woman, dating back to 1609. She was one of the early settlers from England who sought to establish a thriving settlement but, as winter fell, the colony quickly crumbled and the Powhatan Indians were unwilling to help, killing anyone who ventured outside the fort.

Nero's Sunken City: Underwater secrets reveal a seaside city where Nero and Julius Caesar once lived.

Van Gogh's Ear: Details about the night of Dec. 23, 1888, when Vincent van Gogh cut his ear in the town of Arles, France.

Secrets Of Underground London: On the surface, London is a buzzing, modern metropolis--but underneath lies a secret, hidden world. Secrets of Underground London uncovers 2000 years of subterranean history: a world of ancient caves and perfectly preserved Roman remains; mysterious rivers and gruesome plague pits; impenetrable vaults and top-secret bunkers.

Supernature - Wild Flyers: The sky is one of the world's most challenging places to live, but across the planet, an extraordinary range of animals do something we can only dream of take to the air. Some spend their whole lives airborne, while others only visit. But, they all have one thing in common: they survive by taking to the skies.

The Broken Promise - Holocaust Remembrance: The film shines a light on the warnings signs of genocide, and how ordinary citizens can stand against these atrocities — and finally ensure that the promise of “never again,” a refrain after the horrors of the Holocaust, is fulfilled.
