Age Wise: AGE WISE examines best practices with insight from experts and everyday older adults who'll share their personal stories of success. Episodes include: Where We Live, Aging in Place, Caregiving, End of Life and Aging in Our Communities. Age Wise is a local public television program presented by WMHT.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Goin' Back To T-Town: Goin' Back to T-Town tells the story of Greenwood, an extraordinary Black community in Tulsa, Oklahoma, that prospered during the 1920s and 30s despite rampant and hostile segregation.

AMERICAN MASTERS

Amy Tan - Unintended Memoir: Explore the life of the groundbreaking author of "The Joy Luck Club" in this intimate portrait. Archival imagery, home movies, photographs, animation and original interviews create a vivid, colorful journey through Tan's inspiring life and career.

Nam June Paik Moon Is The Oldest TV: See the world through the eyes of Nam June Paik, the father of video art.

Waterman-Duke The Ambassador Of Aloha: Five-time Olympic medalist Duke Kahanamoku shattered records as a swimmer and brought surfing to the world while overcoming rampant racism in a lifetime of personal challenges.

Concert For George: Filmed on November 29, 2002 before a sold-out audience at Royal Albert Hall in London, "The Concert For George" is a beautifully filmed, joyous celebration of some of the most significant music of the 20th Century.

D-Day At Du-Hoc: Tells the remarkable story of the U.S. Army's 2nd Ranger battalion. Led by Lt. Col. James Earl Rudder, the soldiers scaled the 100-foot cliffs of Pointe-du-Hoc in Normandy on June 6, 1944.

Fanny The Right To Rock: Co-founded by Filipina American and queer teenagers, Fanny is the first all women band to release an album with a major record label (Warner/Reprise, 1970). Revered by David Bowie, meet the most ground breaking rock group you've never heard of... yet.

FRONTLINE

America's Dangerous Trucks: An investigation into the fight over measures that could save lives with regard to truck accidents reveals decades of legal manoeuvring, political influence, lax regulation and industry opposition.

Once Upon A Time In Iraq: This is the story of the Iraq war, told by Iraqis who lived through it. They share their personal accounts and lasting memories of life under Saddam Hussein, the U.S.-led invasion of their country and the 17 years of chaos that followed — from the sectarian violence to the rise and brutal reign of ISIS.

Secrets, Politics And The Supreme Court: From veteran FRONTLINE filmmaker Michael Kirk (United States of Secrets, Losing Iraq, Bush's War, The Torture Question) comes the dramatic story of the fight over the CIA's controversial interrogation methods, widely criticized as torture. Based on recently declassified documents and interviews with key political leaders and CIA insiders, the film investigates what the CIA did — and whether it worked.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Anything Goes: Enjoy this London production of Cole Porter's classic musical led by Sutton Foster who reprises her Tony-winning role as Reno Sweeney directed by Kathleen Marshall with favorite songs like "I Get A Kick Out of You" and "You're the Top."

Celebrating 50 Years Of Broadway's Best: A concert celebration at Lincoln Center's David H. Koch Theater features a cast of Broadway veterans and up-and-coming talents performing a revue of milestone shows and songs from 1973-2023.

Richard III: Experience The Public Theater's Free Shakespeare at the Park production of Shakespeare's tragedy with one of his most indelible villains starring Danai Gurira in the title role. Recorded live in July 2022 from Central Park.

Iconic America - Our Symbols & Stories: In this new eight-episode documentary series, David Rubenstein explores America's 400-year history through a close examination of iconic national symbols: indelible artifacts, places, and archetypes. Each episode tells the story of an American symbol to reveal its origins, significance and the arc of its resonance.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Matter Of Mind - My ALS: This film follows three people living with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), a neuromuscular disease with an average survival time of 2-5 years from diagnosis. As ALS progresses, the brain loses the ability to control muscles, resulting in the inability to move, speak, eat, and ultimately breathe. From the nexus of these three stories comes an intimate exploration of the complex choices that people face and the different paths they choose as they live with this progressively debilitating illness.

WMHT 17.1 May 2023 Program Highlights

INDEPENDENT LENS

Sam Now: What happens when a boy and his brother go in search of his missing mother? Sam Now is a coming-of-age documentary that follows Sam Harkness from age 11 to 36 as his once-average, middle class Seattle family is heartbroken and unsure of what to do after his mother suddenly leaves them.

Silent Beauty: In this autobiographical exploration of survivorship, New Orleans journalist and filmmaker Jasmín Mara López unabashedly shares her process of healing from childhood sexual abuse. After Jasmín discloses to her family she'd been abused by her grandfather, she liberates others to come forward in a story of confronting a culture of silence over generational trauma.

Journey Home To The USS Arizona: Narrated by Matthew Broderick, the one-hour documentary JOURNEY HOME TO THE USS ARIZONA follows the family of Raymond Haerry Sr. as they travel 5,000 miles from New Jersey to the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor in Honolulu, Hawaii, to place his ashes aboard the sunken battleship.

Lidia Celebrates America - Flavors That Define Us: Lidia Bastianich, travels from big cities to small towns in rural America to share the inspiring stories of first, second, and third-generation Americans forging their own way, and shaping the shifting definition of what it means to be an American

MASTERPIECE THEATER

Tom Jones: One of the greatest novels in the English language comes to MASTERPIECE in a four-part adaptation of Henry Fielding's Tom Jones, giving a new twist to the tale of a young man's love for a wealthy heiress.

Memphis Belle - Her Final Mission: Follow the story of one of the first American heavy bombers to survive 25 combat missions over the deadly skies of Europe.

NATURE

Attenborough's Wonder Of Song: Sir David Attenborough chooses his favorite recordings from the natural world that have revolutionized our understanding of song. Each one - from the song of the largest lemur to the song of the humpback whale to the song of the lyrebird - was recorded in his lifetime.

Pandas Born To Be Wild: Trek through the steep Qinling Mountains with filmmakers to witness wild pandas' startling behavior.

Hidden Volcano Abyss: Investigate one of the most powerful volcanic eruptions in recorded history.

Into The Megavolcano: In January 2022, one of the most powerful volcanic eruptions in recorded history rocked the islands of Tonga. Join scientists as they investigate what caused the blast, how it spurred a devastating tsunami, and if another eruption could be imminent.

Saving The Right Whale: Follow scientists determined to save the critically endangered right whale. The North Atlantic right whale is on the brink of extinction. But a handful of specialists are determined to help save it as they discover new secrets about the lives of these giants of the sea.

Why Ships Crash: How could a single ship cause a major supply-chain crisis around the globe?
