WMHT 17.1 January 2025 Program Highlights

Animal Babies- First Year On Earth: Meet six baby animals from across the globe. Follow along as they experience joy and hardship, confront near-daily adversities, navigate their habitats, and overcome challenges in their first year of life.

Animals With Cameras: Cameraman Gordon Buchanan works with scientists to put cameras onto animals, revealing unique footage and amazing discoveries about their lives.

Changing Seas: Changing Seas gives viewers a fish-eye view of life in the deep blue. Join scientists as they study earth's last frontier and discover the mysteries of our liquid planet.

Craft In America: The Peabody Award-winning series on PBS, explores America's creative spirit through the language and traditions of the handmade.

Dynamic Planet: The team embarks on a three-year round-the-world trip to the four corners of the seven continents, to meet exceptional people and animals in the face of climate change as they uncover stories of adaptation and resilience in the face of upheaval.

Great Migrations: A four-part docuseries that tells the story of African American movement over the 20th and 21st centuries, and how it has shaped our nation by exploring the meaning behind those movements.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

From Vienna - The New Year's Celebration 2025: Experience this annual beloved concert from the Golden Hall of the Musikverein celebrating the 200th anniversary of the birth of Johann Strauss. Conducted by Riccardo Muti for the seventh time, PBS favorite Hugh Bonneville returns to host.

Iconic America: In this new eight-episode documentary series, David Rubenstein explores America's 400-year history through a close examination of iconic national symbols such as the Hollywood Sign, Fenway Park, American cowboys and the Statue of Liberty: indelible artifacts, places, and archetypes. Each episode tells the story of an American symbol to reveal its origins, significance and the arc of its resonance.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Dallas 2019: Covering five weeks in Dallas the year before the COVID-19 pandemic, including stories that capture the city's pulse and the people who work and live there.

Minted: A group of artists gain global recognition after embracing NFT (non-fungible token)s, but they must deal with the controversies that threaten to undermine this new technology.

Without Arrows: Champion grass dancer Delwin Fiddler Jr. embraces Indigenous culture by returning to his ancestral home on the Cheyenne River Reservation in South Dakota.

Journey To America: A tribute to the over 12 million immigrants entering the United States between 1890-1920.

Ken Burn's Leonardo Da Vinci: Exploring the life and work of Leonardo da Vinci, including how the artist influenced and inspired future generations.

Lucy Worsley Investigates: Lucy Worsley reinvestigates and reveals new evidence about some of British history's biggest unsolved mysteries in a new four-part series from BBC. The mysteries involve the killing of the Princes in the tower in 1483, the true cause of the Black Death, and whether George III really was mad. These mysteries have baffled academics and fascinated history fans for years, and in this series historian, Lucy Worsley turns sleuth by reopening and completely re-evaluating these infamous mysteries.

Lucy Worsley Royal Myths & Secrets: Lucy Worsley dispels the myths behind some of the key moments in British royal history, and she uncovers how historical stories have been manipulated and mythologized for generations.

Luna And Sofie: Luna Kunath is strong-willed but her penchant for naivety gets her into trouble. Sophie Pohlmann seems more mature, but her desire for harmony and fairness can be her weakness. From Walter Presents, in German with English subtitles.

My Grandparent's War: To commemorate the 80th anniversary of the start of World War II, celebrated actors explore their grandparents' extraordinary wartime stories.

NATURE

Attenborough And The Jurassic Sea: Sir David Attenborough unearths a once-in-a-lifetime discovery: the fossil of a giant Pliosaur, the largest Jurassic predator ever known.

Big Cats Small World: On the shores of Botswana's Gomoti River, three big cats have made themselves a home. An aging lion has his hands full with new cubs; a cheetah mother races to get her five cubs to independence, while a male leopard embarks on a bumpy journey to fatherhood. To succeed, these cats must use their unique skills to avoid lethal encounters, outsmart rivals, and thrive in a crowded neighborhood. Narrated by David Oyelowo.

Patrick And The Whale: Follow Patrick Dykstra in his quest to connect with and understand the hidden nature of the sperm whale, shining a light on their intelligence and complexity, as well as their relationship with humankind.

NOVA

Black Hole Apocalypse: Black holes are the most enigmatic, mysterious, and exotic objects in the universe. But astrophysicists are realizing that they may actually be common and may be essential to understanding how our universe unfolded. In NOVA's two-hour Black Hole Apocalypse special, astrophysicist and author Janna Levin takes viewers on a mind-bending journey to the frontiers of black hole research.

Extreme Airport Engineering: A team of designers, engineers and construction workers build a new world-class airport in New York.

What Are UFOs?: Unidentified Flying Objects have long captivated the imagination of the public, but for decades most scientists treated the subject as taboo. Now, these mysterious phenomena are moving out of the shadows and into the light, as NASA pledges to study them scientifically. So, what exactly does science have to say on the matter?

Resistance They Fought Back: We've all heard of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, but most people have no idea how widespread and prevalent Jewish resistance to Nazi barbarism was. Instead, it's widely believed "Jews went to their deaths like sheep to the slaughter." Filmed in Poland, Lithuania, Latvia, Israel, and the U.S., Resistance – They Fought Back provides a much-needed corrective to this myth of Jewish passivity.

SECRETS OF THE DEAD

Abandoning The Titanic: Investigators search for the identity of the captain of a "mystery ship" that turned away from Titanic the night it sank in 1912.

Death In Britannia: A skeleton dating back to the Roman occupation of Britain provokes further study after scientists see an iron nail driven through its heel bone, possibly indicating the person was crucified.

World War Speed: Historian James Holland investigates the uses of stimulants by British and American troops during World War II and the role that drugs played in combat.

Thomas Jefferson: Ken Burns tells the story of Thomas Jefferson's life, with Sam Waterston as the voice of Jefferson.
