## GREAT PERFORMANCES

**George Jones Still Playin' Possum:** A tribute concert honoring country musician George Jones features Brad Paisley, Dierks Bentley, Jelly Roll, Tanya Tucker, Wynonna, Sam Moore, Travis Tritt, Jamey Johnson, Uncle Kracker and more.

**The LA Philharmonic Celebrates Frank Gehry:** Celebrate 20 years at Walt Disney Concert Hall with the LA Phil in a tribute to its architect. Led by Gustavo Dudamel, the concert includes a piece composed and conducted by Esa-Pekka Salonen, performances by Herbie Hancock and H.E.R., and more.

**The Magic Of Spirituals:** The behind-the-scenes story of Kathleen Battle and Jessye Norman's concert of spirituals at Carnegie Hall on March 18, 1990.

**Gospel:** Dig deep into the origin story of Black gospel music, coming out of slavery, blending with the blues tradition, and soaring to new heights during the Great Migration. From Mahalia to Kirk Franklin, in the last century, gospel music has become the dominant form of African American religious expression and provided a soundtrack of healing and uplift to those at the front lines of protest and change.

**Harriet Tubman - Visions Of Freedom:** Go beyond the legend and meet the inspiring woman who repeatedly risked her own life and freedom to liberate others from slavery. Born 200 years ago in Maryland, Harriet Tubman was a conductor of the Underground Railroad, a Civil War scout, nurse and spy, and one of the greatest freedom fighters in our nation's history.

**Henry Johnson - A Tale Of Courage:** Henry Johnson was an African American U.S. Army soldier who fought heroically in the 369th Infantry Regiment of the U.S. Army in World War I. A Tale of Courage tells the story of his life, his family, and the extensive efforts to honor his bravery and courage after his death.

**Il Volo - Tribute To Ennio Morricone:** Pay tribute to the legendary Oscar, Grammy and Golden Globe-winning Italian film composer. Filmed in 2021 at the Arena Di Verona, the program showcases arrangements from Morricone and fan favorites from Il Volo's most popular albums, accompanied by incredible theatrical and musical performers.

## WMHT 17.1 February 2024 Program Highlights

**Australian Bushfire Rescue:** The rescue, rehabilitation and eventual release of koalas, kangaroos, wombats and endangered species of parrots that survived the bushfires in Australia.

**Flyways:** They are the superhighways of the sky. Biologists call them “flyways,” and each spring and fall billions of birds hit these atmospheric roads for their annual migrations, which can stretch thousands of miles.

**Gorilla:** This documentary presents an intimate look at a silverback and his family, and features a newborn baby gorilla, brave researchers, forest elephants, buffalos and the last remaining wild coastline in the African tropics.

**Patrick And The Whale:** For years, Patrick Dykstra has traveled the globe following and diving with whales, learning how whales see, hear and perceive other creatures in the water.

**Primates:** Uncover primates’ complex relationship dynamics, how they learn to hunt and feed, their courtship rituals and more.

**Raising The Dinosaur Giant:** Have scientists discovered the biggest animal to have ever walked the planet?

### NOVA

**Building The Eiffel Tower:** The three decades of engineering, innovations, successes and failures that led to the creation of the Eiffel Tower in Paris.

**Easter Island Origins:** This is the story of a team of archaeologists and a 75-person crew who sought to unravel a central mystery of Easter Island: how hundreds of giant stone statues that dominate the island's coast were moved and erected.

**Hunt For The Oldest DNA:** Scientists discover the oldest DNA ever found and reveal the genes of long-extinct creatures that once thrived in the Arctic.

**Reef Rescue:** Marine biologists from the Bahamas to Christmas Island to Australia fight against the clock to save the coral reefs from extinction.

**When Whales Could Walk:** Paleontologists uncover a whole new species of whale in a parched valley not far from Cairo.

**Operation Maneater - Polar Bear:** Mark Evans travels to the shores of Canada's Hudson Bay, where polar bears are causing havoc in isolated communities.

**Reframing An Empire:** Explore the captivating journey of artist Thomas Cole and his profound impact on American identity.

**Searching For Timbuctoo:** The little-known story of a Black settlement, established in the wilds of upstate New York.

### SECRETS OF THE DEAD

**Graveyard Of The Giant Beasts:** A mining operation in Cerrejon, Northern Colombia, opened a window onto a previously unknown period of the earth’s history and a world teeming with giant creatures emerged.

**Jamestown's Dark Winter:** The site of the first permanent English colony the Americas settled in 1607 .

**The Alcatraz Escape:** Scientists theorize that the three men who escaped Alcatraz in 1962 may have been able to survive, contradicting the original thought that they perished at sea.

**The Woman In The Iron Coffin:** Follow a team of forensic experts as they investigate the preserved remains of a young African American woman from 19th century New York.

**Sister Boniface Mysteries:** A light-hearted murder mystery series starring a Vespa driving, crime solving Catholic nun.

**Shuttlesworth:** Rev. Fred Shuttlesworth's work not only ended legal segregation but led directly to the Civil and Voting Rights Acts - and inspired freedom movements around the world.

**The Blind Boys Of Alabama:** Formed as a gospel a capella group at the Alabama Institute for the Negro Blind in 1939, the group toured for almost 40 years on the black gospel circuit all over the country.

**The Dream Whisperer:** In the midst of segregation, the all-Black Tennessee A&I Tigers were the first collegiate basketball team to win three consecutive national championships.

**The Early Battle For Civil Rights:** Explores the Black elite and intellectual society at the turn of the 20th century, a class rarely presented.

**The Queen Anthology - A Life On Film:** A treasure trove of short films that presents a unique perspective on the remarkable life and reign of Queen Elizabeth II,

**Variety Studio - Actors On Actors:** Actors engage in intimate one-on-one discussions about their craft and work.
