The LA Philharmonic Celebrates Frank Gehry: Celebrate 20 years at Walt Disney Concert Hall with the LA Phil in a tribute to its architect. Led by Gustavo Dudamel, the concert includes a piece composed and conducted by Esa-Pekka Salonen, performances by Herbie Hancock and H.E.R., and more.

The Magic Of Spirituals: The behind-the-scenes story of Kathleen Battle and Jessye Norman's concert of spirituals at Carnegie Hall on March 18, 1990.

Born 200 years ago in Maryland, Harriet Tubman was a conductor of the Underground Railroad, a Civil War scout, nurse and spy, and one of the greatest freedom fighters in our nation's history.

<u>Henry Johnson - A Tale Of Courage</u>: Henry Johnson was an African American U.S. Army soldier who fought heroically in the 369th Infantry Regiment of the U.S. Army in World War I. A Tale of Courage tells the story of his life, his family, and the extensive efforts to honor his bravery and courage after his death.

## WMHT 17.1 February 2024 Program Highlights

<u>Australian Bushfire Rescue</u>: The rescue, rehabilitation and eventual release of koalas, kangaroos, wombats and endangered species of parrots that survived the bushfires in Australia.

<u>Flyways</u>: They are the superhighways of the sky. Biologists call them "flyways," and each spring and fall billions of birds hit these atmospheric roads for their annual migrations, which can stretch thousands of miles.

<u>Gorilla</u>: This documentary presents an intimate look at a silverback and his family, and features a newborn baby gorilla, brave researchers, forest elephants, buffalos and the last remaining wild coastline in the African tropics.

<u>Patrick And The Whale</u>: For years, Patrick Dykstra has traveled the globe following and diving with whales, learning how whales see, hear and perceive other creatures in the water.

<u>Primates</u>: Uncover primates' complex relationship dynamics, how they learn to hunt and feed, their courtship rituals and more.

<u>The Woman In The Iron Coffin</u>: Follow a team of forensic experts as they investigate the preserved remains of a young African American woman from 19th century New York.

Sister Boniface Mysteries: A light-hearted murder mystery series starring a Vespa driving, crime solving Catholic nun.

<u>Shuttlesworth</u>: Rev. Fred Shuttlesworth's work not only ended legal segregation but led directly to the Civil and Voting Rights Acts - and inspired freedom movements around the world.

The Blind Boys Of Alabama: Formed as a gospel a capella group at the Alabama Institute for the Negro Blind in 1939, the group toured for almost 40 years on the black gospel circuit all over the country.

<u>The Dream Whisperer</u>: In the midst of segregation, the all-Black Tennessee A&I Tigers were the first collegiate basketball team to win three consecutive national championships.

The Early Battle For Civil Rights: Explores the Black elite and intellectual society at the turn of the 20th century, a class rarely presented.

<u>The Queen Anthology - A Life On Film</u>: A treasure trove of short films that presents a unique perspective on the remarkable life and reign of Queen Elizabeth II,

Variety Studio - Actors On Actors: Actors engage in intimate one-on-one discussions about their craft and work.
