AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

The Cancer Detectives: The fight against cervical cancer and three people whose work helped slash death rates from the disease by more than 60 percent.

The Sun Queen: Scientist Mária Telkes dedicated her career to harnessing the power of the sun. Though undercut and thwarted by her male colleagues, she persevered to design the first successfully solar-heated house in 1948 and held more than 20 patents.

AMERICAN MASTERS

Doc Severinsen: Jazz trumpeter Doc Severinsen forms a close relationship with talk show host Johnny Carson during his years

Mae West: The life and career of performer Mae West, whose work spanned eight decades and included acting, vaudeville, dance and playwriting.

Moynihan: The life of long-serving Sen. Daniel Patrick Moynihan (D-N.Y.), considered to have one of the broadest public careers in U.S. political history.

Ancient Roads - From Christ To Constantine: An entertaining and enlightening journey, full of sights and sounds that capture the essence of Christianity's early history and its incredible triumph against all odds.

Ann Morrow-Lindbergh - You'll Have The Sky: Brings one of the 20th century's best-loved writers out from the shadow of her often controversial husband, aviator Charles Lindbergh. This film is an evocative portrait of a woman whose work continues to speak to readers today, and whose life is a key to understanding the changing worlds of aviation, women, and celebrity in the

Beauty On The Wing - The Monarch Butterfly: Every stage of the butterfly's life cycle is experienced in vibrant close-up, from mating to egg to caterpillar to adult, and set against the backdrop of sea and forest, sun and wind.

Butterfly Town, USA: The documentary centers on a community of activists who took action to save the Monarch Butterfly Grove Sanctuary and their efforts that led to a clash between activists and the city about how best to protect the site.

FRONTLINE

Lethal Restraint: Drawing on police records, autopsy reports and body cam footage to investigate deaths after police used tactics like prone restraint and other "less lethal" force.

Gennett Suite: One hundred years ago, many of the greatest jazz pioneers made their first recordings at a little studio in Richmond, Indiana – the Gennett Studios. Today, Indiana University Jacobs School of Music Associate Professor Brent Wallarab conducts the IU Student Jazz Ensemble in an original production of The Gennett Suite, a tribute to those early jazz recording artists, recorded at the WTIU studios.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Merry Wives: The Public Theater's Shakespeare in the Park in South Harlem presents a Shakespearean comedy about the trickster Falstaff and the wily wives who outwit him.

The Conductor: Marin Alsop's quest to be the first female music director of a major symphony, featuring footage of her and mentor Leonard Bernstein set to a soundtrack of her performances.

GREAT PERFORMANCES AT THE MET

Dead Man Walking: Joyce DiDonato stars as Sister Helen based on the real-life memoir about her fight for the soul of a condemned murderer.

Great Yellowstone Thaw: Journey with Kirk Johnson to Yellowstone, where wolves, grizzlies, beavers and Great Gray owls survive one of the greatest seasonal changes on the planet. As the temperature swings 140 degrees, cameras capture how the animals cope.

Impossible Builds - Ice World: Over the top, ambitious and nature-defying, China's incredible Ice World will transform 37 acres of sub-tropical quarry into a sub-zero ski resort.

IN THEIR OWN WORDS

Princess Diana: Meet those closest to Princess Diana and follow her story as she grew from a shy, aristocratic schoolgirl into a dynamic force for change.

Queen Elizabeth II: Follow Queen Elizabeth II's remarkable life, from her youth to her uncle's abdication, her father's coronation as King George VI, her experience during World War II, her sudden ascension to the throne and her eventful reign of more than 60 years.

INDEPENDENT LENS

Greener Pastures: A look at American farming through the stories of Midwestern farmers facing increased economic uncertainty.

Ireland - Made With Love: Explore the legacy of traditional Irish craftsmanship through the skill, pride and love that go into legendary Irish products.

MASTERPIECE THEATER

Alice And Jack: The story of a 16-year relationship between two imperfect lovers and its highs and lows.

Nolly: story of Noele "Nolly" Gordon, one of the most famous faces on British TV in the 1960s and 70s, whose unceremonious firing from her hit show at the height of her career was front-page news.

Menus-Plaisirs-Les Troisgros: A 93-year-old director reveals the inner-workings of a French restaurant that's held three Michelin stars for more than 50 years. The Troisgros family has three restaurants in total.

NATURE

Primates: Uncover primates' complex relationship dynamics, how they learn to hunt and feed, their courtship rituals and more.

Remarkable Rabbits: How hares differ from rabbits; how swamp rabbits have managed to survive in an ever-changing landscape; snowshoe hares; progress made by scientists to save rabbit species from extinction.

NOVA

Arctic Sinkholes: Investigates explosions in Siberia and other evidence that thawing permafrost in the Arctic is releasing vast amounts of methane, a potent greenhouse gas.

AI Revolution: The power and potential of artificial intelligence (AI) technology.

Butterfly Blueprints: The hidden scientific secrets of butterflies and how they are inspiring cutting-edge technical innovations.

Hidden Volcano Abyss: Geologists investigate the January 2022 volcanic eruption that rocked the Pacific islands of Tonga and sent shockwaves around the world.

Polar Extremes: Following a trail of fossils found in all the wrong places such as beech trees in Antarctica and hippo-like mammals in the Arctic. Uncovering the bizarre history of the poles, from miles-thick ice sheets to warm polar forests.

Reef Rescue: Marine biologists from the Bahamas to Christmas Island to Australia fight against the clock to save the coral reefs from extinction.

Star Chasers Of Senegal: Senegalese astronomer Maram Kaire investigates his nation's history of astronomy, which stretches back thousands of years.

Operation Maneater - Polar Bear: Mark Evans travels to the shores of Canada's Hudson Bay, where polar bears are causing havoc in isolated communities.

Penny - Champion Of The Marginalized: Criminal defense attorney and art collector Penny Cooper offers a unique perspective on topics ranging from criminal justice to the global contemporary art market.

RFDS - Royal Flying Doctor Service: Based on remarkable real-life stories, this gripping drama series follows the modern-day heroes of the Royal Flying Doctor Service as they navigate private lives as turbulent and profound as the heart-stopping emergencies they attend to across some of the most beautiful and inhospitable places in the Australian outback.

The Path Forward - Remembering Willowbrook: In 1972, Geraldo Rivera produced an exposé on the Willowbrook State School in Staten Island, shocking the nation and forever changing the treatment of people with disabilities in the state and across the country.

World War II - Her War Her Story: Explore the stories of women caught up in World War II, from the American Home Front to Auschwitz Concentration Camp in Poland. Included in this hour-long film are also the personal stories of the incredible women who served in a war that proved women were equal to men when it came to patriotism, service, or in some cases, self-preservation during watershed moments which called for steadfastness.
