

The gosling book

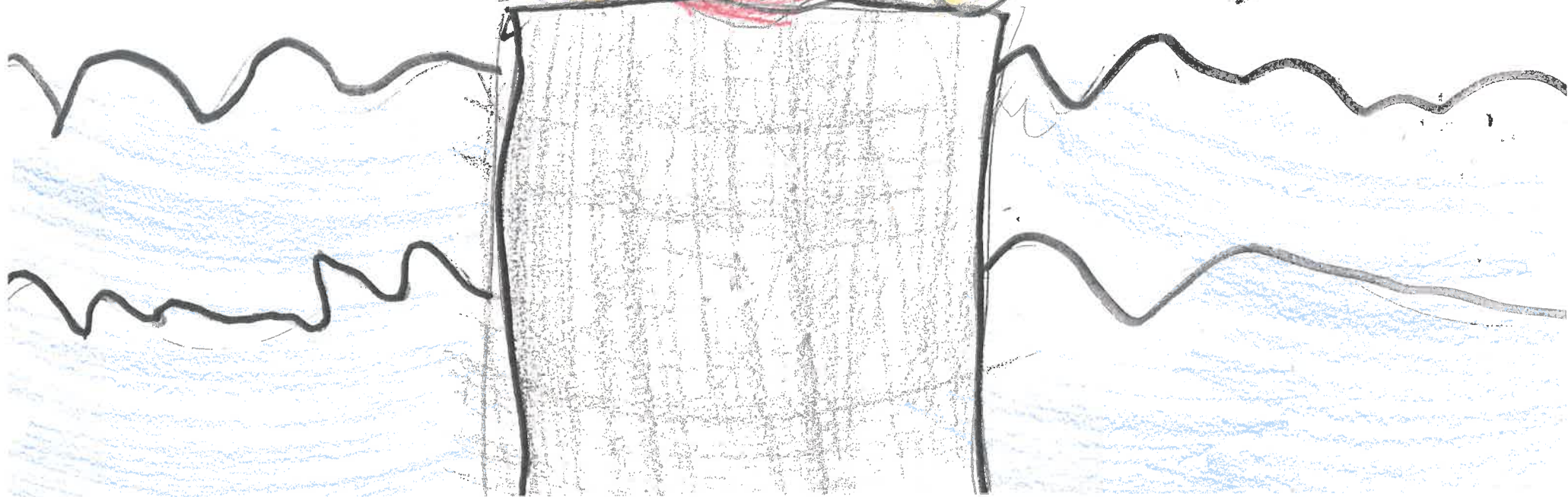

Two out of her three eggs hatch and the baby goslings peer out. They are looking for their mom. Mommy goose feeds them the worms for dinner.

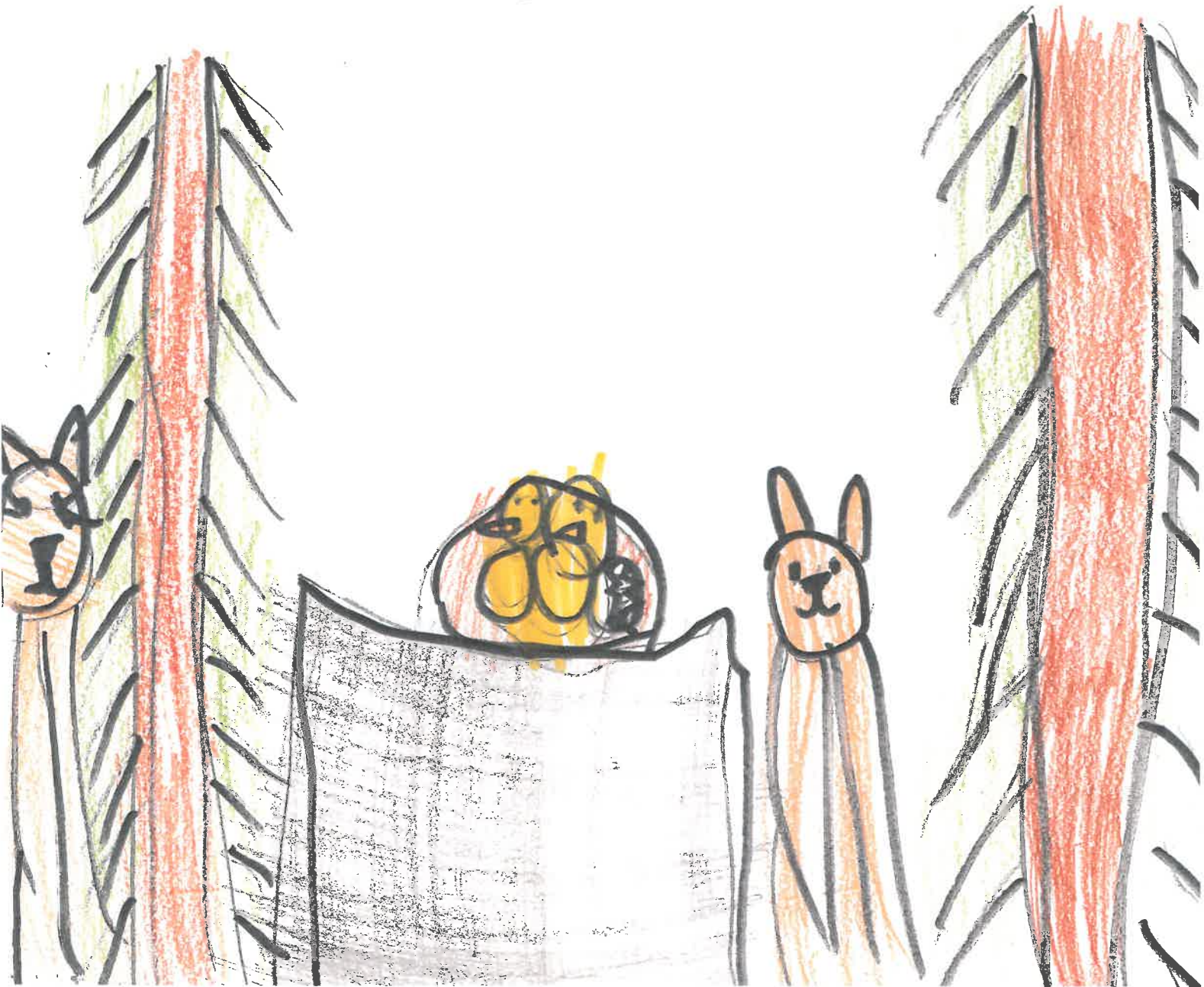
The goslings snuggle next to the third unhatched egg and keep it warm. They are about to close their eyes for a nap when a fox jumps out.
