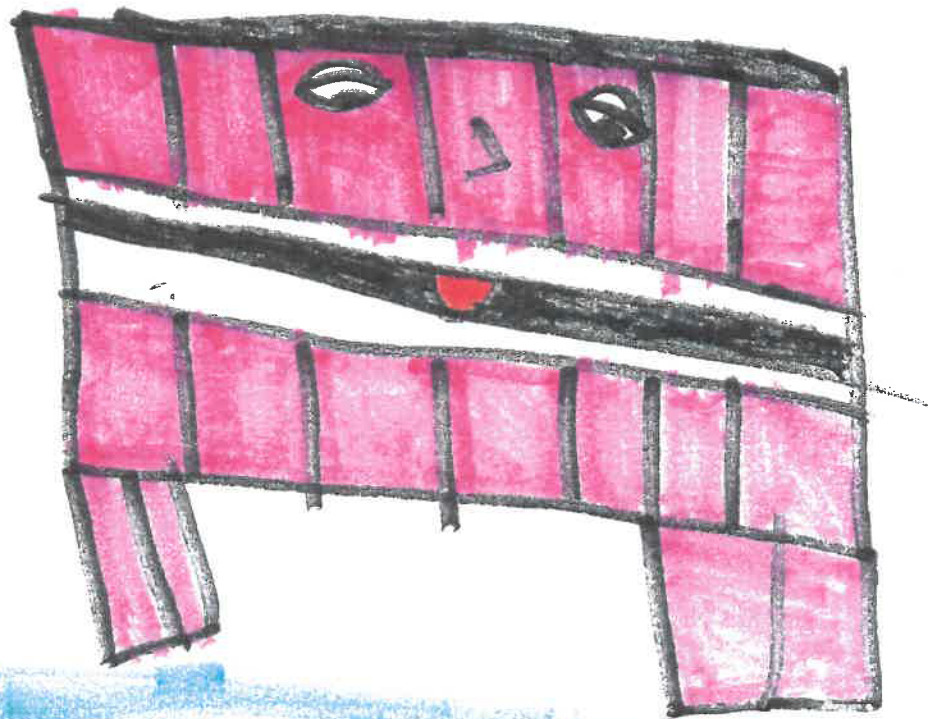
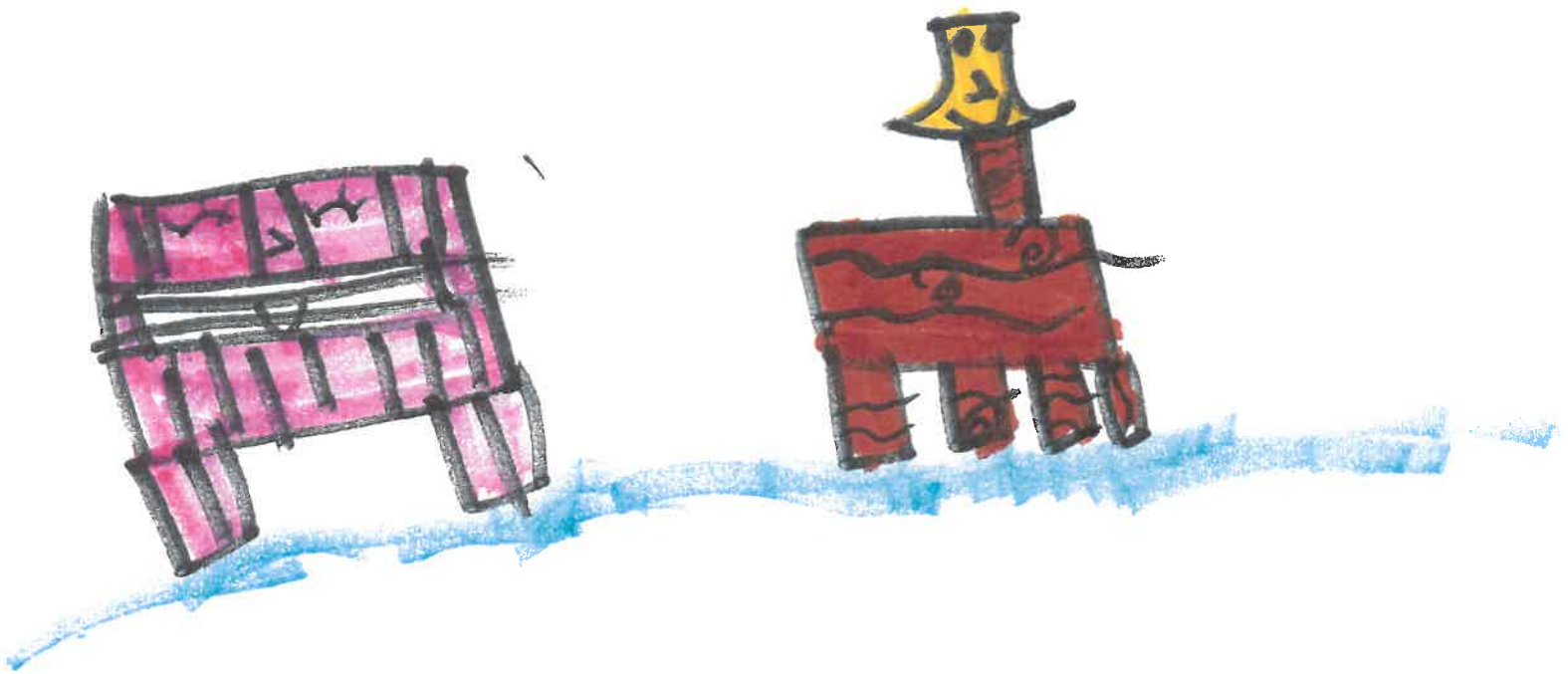


The Annoyed Couch

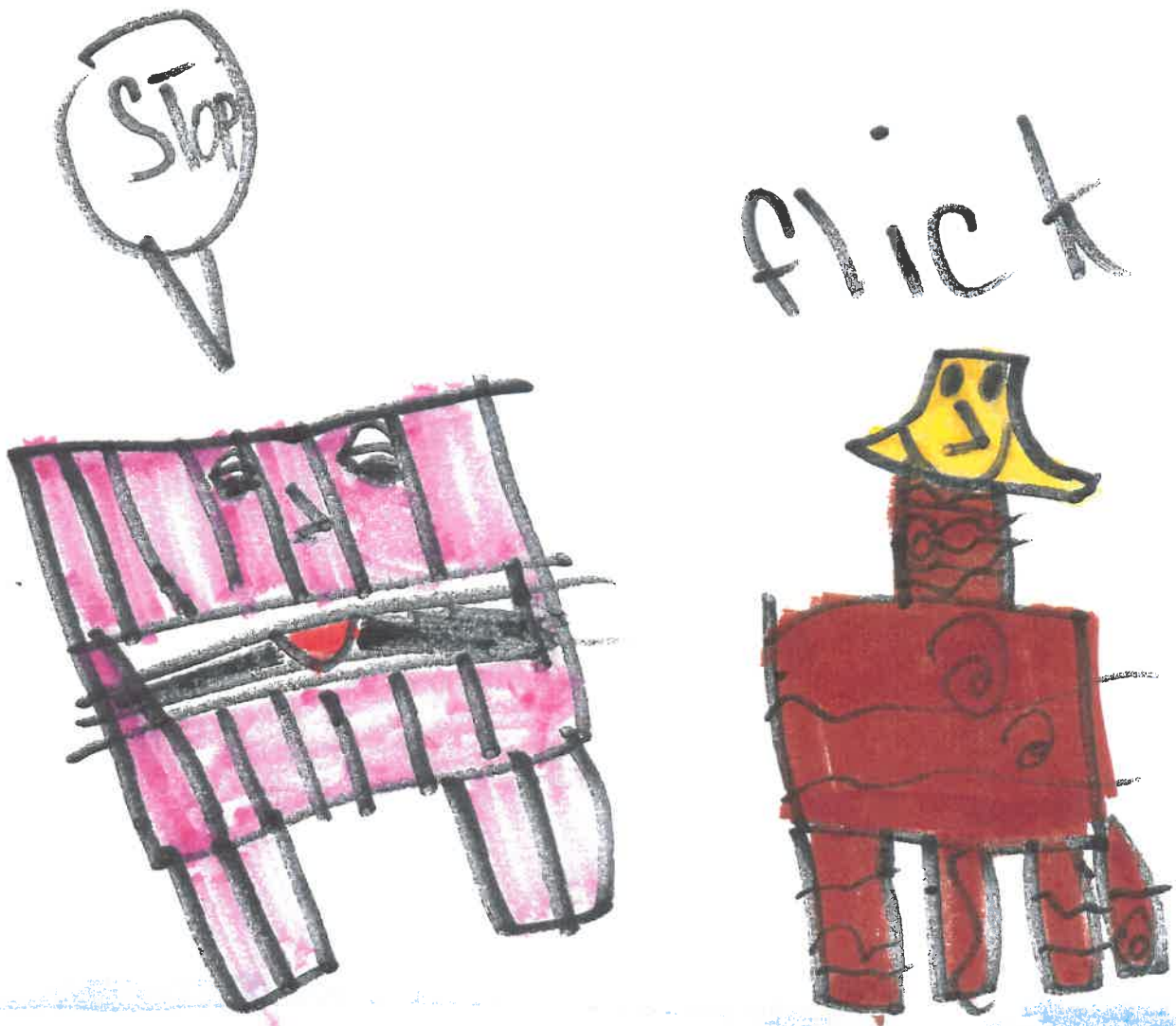

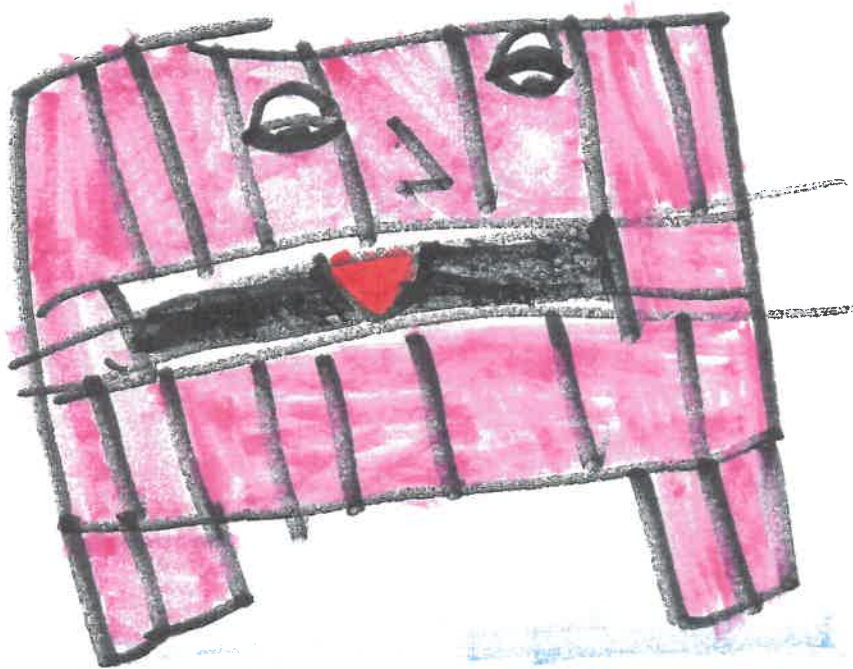
The Lamp starts flickering. The Couch wakes up as The Man drops a cup. He sees The Lamp flickering and thinks that is what had woken him up.



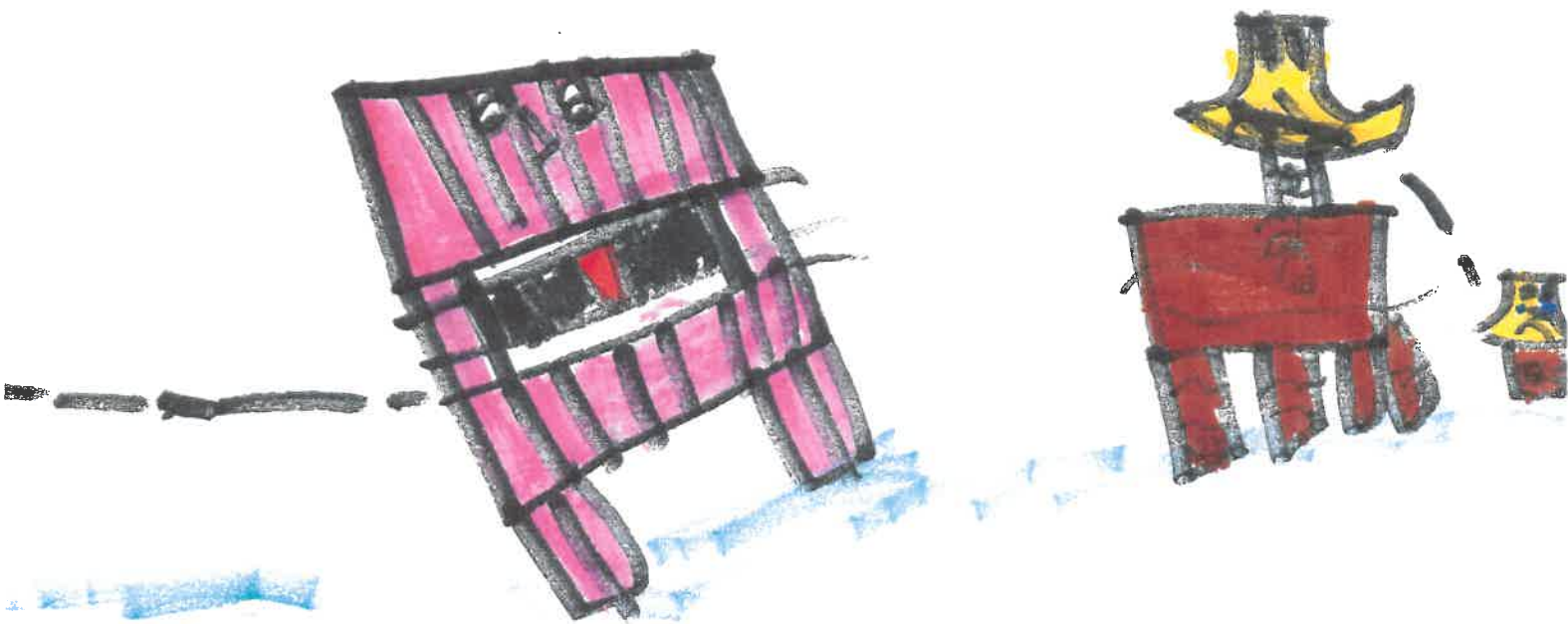
The Couch becomes annoyed and thinks The Lamp is flickering for fun. "STOP FLICKERING" yells The Couch in a low mean tone.



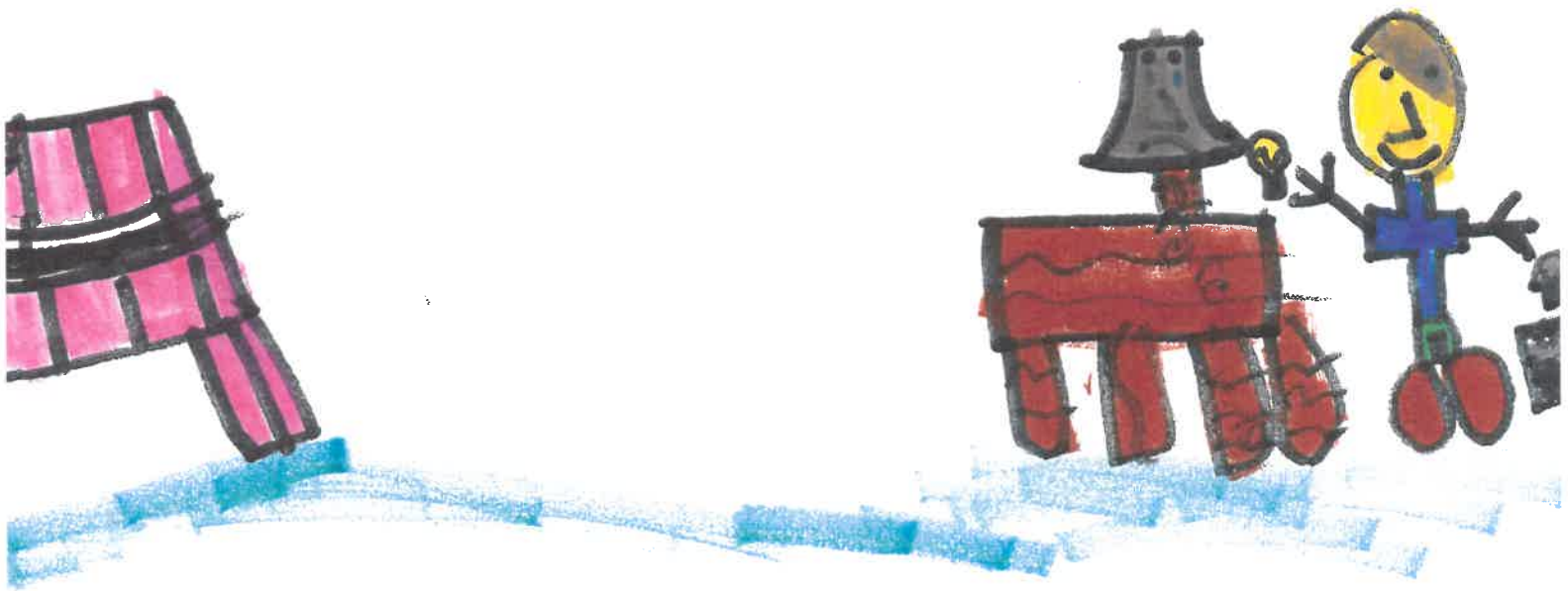
The Lamp doesn't know she has an old bulb. "I'm not flickering," says The Lamp in a high tone with a Texas accent.
