PBS Western Reserve leader to retire

Trina Cutter, president and CEO of PBS Western Reserve, will retire from the organization on July 31, 2023, following more than 20 years of leadership.

"Trina's retirement will mark the end of a remarkable career with PBS Western Reserve," said Romona Davis, chairwoman of the organization's board of directors. "The board and I thank her for her strategic leadership through many changes and challenges, including the transition from analog to digital broadcasting and the Great Recession of 2008. Trina has provided outstanding leadership and service to the staff, board, station and community."

"Everything has its season," Cutter said. "Without a doubt the five general managers who came before me contributed to the success that PBS Western Reserve enjoys today. I held the reins during the station's winter season where we put foundational systems and processes in place; changed the corporate structure to be community-centric; situated the station on solid financial footing; and most recently installed a Blogosphere, Podcast/Vlog Studio and a professional broadcast production studio. The station is currently into the early years of spring, full of growth and infinite possibilities to serve its community. I look forward to learning about the great things the next CEO will accomplish."

Cutter is a certified yoga instructor and dharma coach. Shortly after departing PBS Western Reserve, she plans to move to Asheville, N.C., to obtain an Ayurveda practitioners license. "I am rewiring more than retiring," Cutter stated. "In my next career, I plan to teach people how they can become the CEO of their body, mind and spirit life using the same strategies and processes I've used as the CEO of two public television stations."

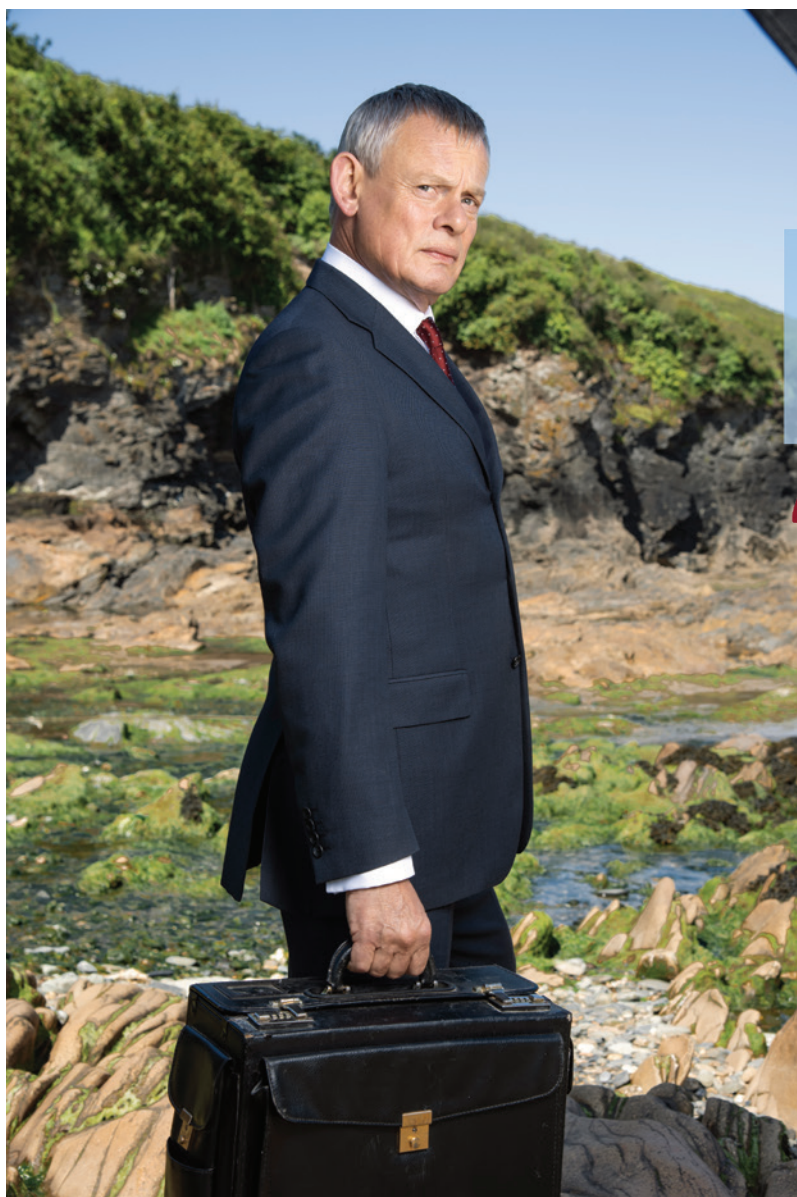

son. With Louisa's encouragement, James Henry grows attached to Buddy the dog, though Martin has less feelings about the four-legged friend. Louisa finds it difficult to manage all her responsibilities as she begins the search for a new nanny and considers making a career change, causing a rift with Martin.

Meanwhile, Portwenn is abuzz as the residents prepare for a wedding. Bert and Al Large hope to profit from the festivities, but when Martin's Aunt Ruth (Eileen Atkins) considers selling the family farm, her decision causes trouble for their business endeavors. As some relationships bloom and others falter, can Martin cope with all

the changes? Or will he risk the fragile unity he's forged with his family?

But an accident plus shocking announcements threaten the stability and happiness found by Grantchester's vicar and police detective duo. Exploring faith, forgiveness and redemption, this explosive season of "Grantchester" tests Will and Geordie to the limit.

RAY introduces viewers to Leicester-born Rachita Ray (Parminder Nagra), a police officer who takes on a case that forces her to confront a lifelong personal conflict between her British identity and her South Asian heritage. In the gripping four-part series, D.I. Ray goes on a journey that sees her uncover a complex web of deceit within organized crime, while laying bare the wounds deep within herself that she's spent a lifetime ignoring.

During its UK broadcast, the drama received critical praise for its updated take on the formulaic crime thriller, "A police procedural with a fresh perspective..." cheered The Guardian, and National World commended "...a clever blend of thoughtful character study with an engaging police procedural, worth watching for its lead alone."

Nagra is joined by a highly talented cast including Gemma Whelan as her boss DCI Kerry Henderson; Jamie Bamber as D.I. Martyn Hunter — who is also Ray's fiancé; and Maanuv Thiara as P.S. Tony Khatri, Rachita's partner.





This new six-part documentary series, hosted by biologist and Princeton University professor Shane Campbell-Staton, embarks on a journey to understand all the ways humans have impacted the planet. 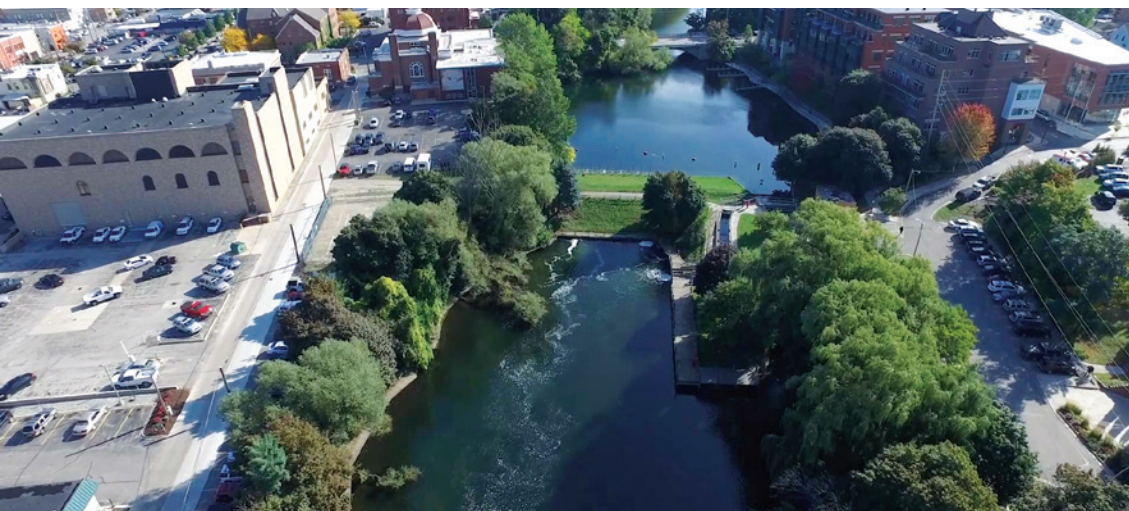

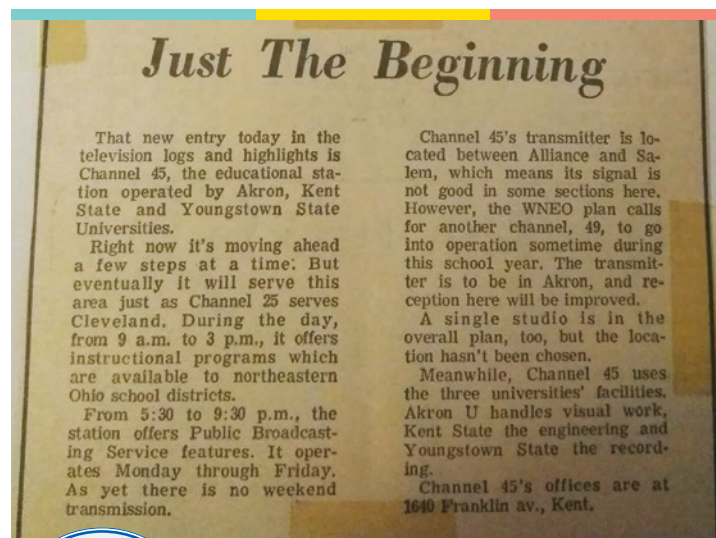

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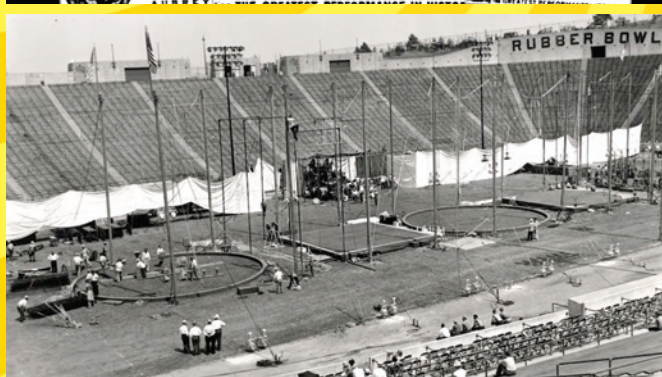


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Akron, Ringling, and the 'Blue Heaven' Circuit

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
