Medicare Enrollment	Newsmakers	11/14/24 11/17/24	7:00pm 12:30pm	30 minutes	This episode featured Carolyn Conners from SWIRCA, and Melanie Garland from SHIP discussing he deadlines, requirements, and options for the current Medicare Enrollment period. Discussed were costs for various plans, coverage, and possibly penalties.
War Veterans	Monumental Honor: Celebrating The Honor Flight of Southern Indiana	11/7/24 11/10/24	7:00pm 3:00pm	60 minutes	This new local-produced documentary highlighted the veteran experiences as they traveled to Washington DC thanks to the efforts of the many volunteers of the Honor Flight of Southern Indiana program. Participants, Volunteers, and Guardians shared their heart-warming stories about their individual experiences.
Climate Change	Healing the Heartland	11/14/24 11/16/24	8:00pm 8:00pm	60 minutes	This new local-produced documentary was produced in partnership with the Evansville Climate Action Collaborative and featured interviews with over 20 local organizations and citizens that are working to reduce climate change.

Each candidate had 3 minutes to introduce themselves, tell the viewers about their qualifications and their priorities if elected.
Local Election	Shively and Shoulders	10/17/24 10/20/24	7:30pm 10:30am	30 minutes	This episode featured candidates for Indiana State Senate District 50, Evansville School Board candidates, and candidates for Vanderburgh County Circuit Court. Each candidate has three minute to introduce themselves, tell the viewers about their qualifications and their priorities if elected.
Local Election	Shively and Shoulders	11/14/24 11/17/24	7:30pm 10:30am	30 minutes	This post-election episode featured hosts Judge Les Shively and attorney Pat Shoulders discussing and analyzing the results of local, state, and national elections.
LGBTQ	Out and About in Evansville	12/1/24 12/4/24	9:30pm 8:30pm	120 minutes	This two-part documentary focused on the history of the Evansville's LGBTQ community from the 1950's to present. Presented through interviews with local residents, viewers learned about the trials and tribulations the community faced.
Local Roads	Newsmakers	12/19/24 12/22/24	7:00pm 12:30PM	30 minutes	This episode featured guests Gary Bryan from INDOT, Nichole Menton with the Lloyd FU project, and Mike Labitzke with the Evansville Street Department as they discussed the recent upgrades to may state and local highways and streets.
Local History	Historic Churches Of Evansville	11/28/24	8:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced documentary highlighted the oldest churches in Evansville by examining the history of their religion and buildings.
