This listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

| Flash Flooding Awareness | News makers | 8/7/25 | 7:00pm | 30 minutes | This episode featured local weather and emergency management experts about the risk of flash flooding in our area and how to receive alerts. |
| Missing Person Alerts | News makers | 8/21/25 8/24/25 | Thursday 7pm and Sunday 12:30pm | 30 minutes | This episode featured local officials talking about how important to be informed about missing people in the area and how to receive alerts. |
| Road Projects Update | News makers | 8/28/25 8/31/25 | Thursday at 7:00pm and Sunday at 12:30pm | 30 minutes | This episode covered the progress of road projects in the entire area, including the Lloyd Expressway, INDOT projects, the I69 bridge project, and Evansville projects. |
| Rural Broadband Update | News makers | 9/11/25 9/14/25 | Thursday 7pm and Sunday 12:30pm | 30 minutes | This episode featured state and local representatives giving the status of the statewide rural broadband initiative. |
| State Politics | Shively & Shoulders | 7/10/25 7/13/25 | 7:30pm 10:30am | 30 minutes | This program hosted by local leaders, featured an interview with IN Lt. Governor Micah Beckwith. A wide range of issues were covered. |
| Local Schools | Shively and Shoulders | 9/11/25 9/14/25 | 7:30pm 10:30am | 30 minutes | This episode featured new Superintendent Dr. Darla Hooper discussing her efforts to improve the Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation and what the future holds for parents and students. |
| Local Music | Kent Parker: The Way | 7/10/25 | 8:00pm | 60 minutes | This documentary follows a local musician as he produced his own record. |
| Local history | Homegrown Heritage | 7/12/25 | 7:00pm | 60 minutes | This locally produced documentary speaks with local residents about their experiences growing up on family farms. |
| Education | Regional Voices | 8/24/25 | 10:30am | 30 minutes | This episode of local Rotary speakers featured the Indiana Secretary of Education, Dr. Katie Jenner. She discussed a variety of educational issues. |
| Local History | A West Side Nut Club Story | 9/25/25 9/27/25 | 8:00pm 7:00pm | 60 minutes | This locally-produced documentary explained the history of The West Side Nut Club, which was founded in 1914 and its philanthropy has greatly influenced the region. |
