<b>Historical Preservation</b>	Newsmakers	4/3/25 4/6/15	Thursday 7pm and Sunday 12:30pm	30 minutes	This episode featured Jill Hahn discussing the a project to renovate the Evansville Coliseum so that it can once again become a working venue.
<b>State Legislation</b>	Lawmakers	4/1/25- 5/4/13/25	Fridays at 5:30pm and Sundays at 11:30am	30 minutes	This locally-produced series featured local State Legislators discussing the events and bills for the past week with Host Noah Alatzia.
<b>Climate Change</b>	Newsmakers	4/10/25 4/13/25	Thursday 7pm and Sunday 12:30pm	30 minutes	This episode featured local experts that discussed effect to our region from Climate change and the efforts being done to counteract the changes.

<b>Local Art</b>	An Interview with Kevin Titzer	5/15/25 5/17/25	8:30pm 7:30pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced interview program featured artist Kevin Titzer and Dr. Del Doughty from the University of Southern Indiana discussing Kevin's recent installation at USI with Host Noah Alatzia.
<b>Education</b>	Shively and Shoulders	6/12/25 6/15/25	7:30pm and 10:30am	30 minutes	This episode features hosts Judge Les Shively and attorney Pat Shoulders discuss the past and future of Ivy Tech with outgoing President Dr. Sue Elsperman.
<b>Caregiving</b>	Newsmakers	6/26/25 6/29/25	7:00pm 12:30pm	30 minutes	This episode featured representatives from SWIRCA, Gibson County Council on Aging discussing local resources available to caregivers. It also featured participant from the PBS special "Caregiving" discussing her personal caregiving journey.
<b>Disasters</b>	A Time of Peril	5/3/25	9:00pm	90 minutes	This program was originally produced in 1980, this discussion and look at the 1937 Tri-State Flood was presented following the flooding that took place in early 2025 in Evansville.
